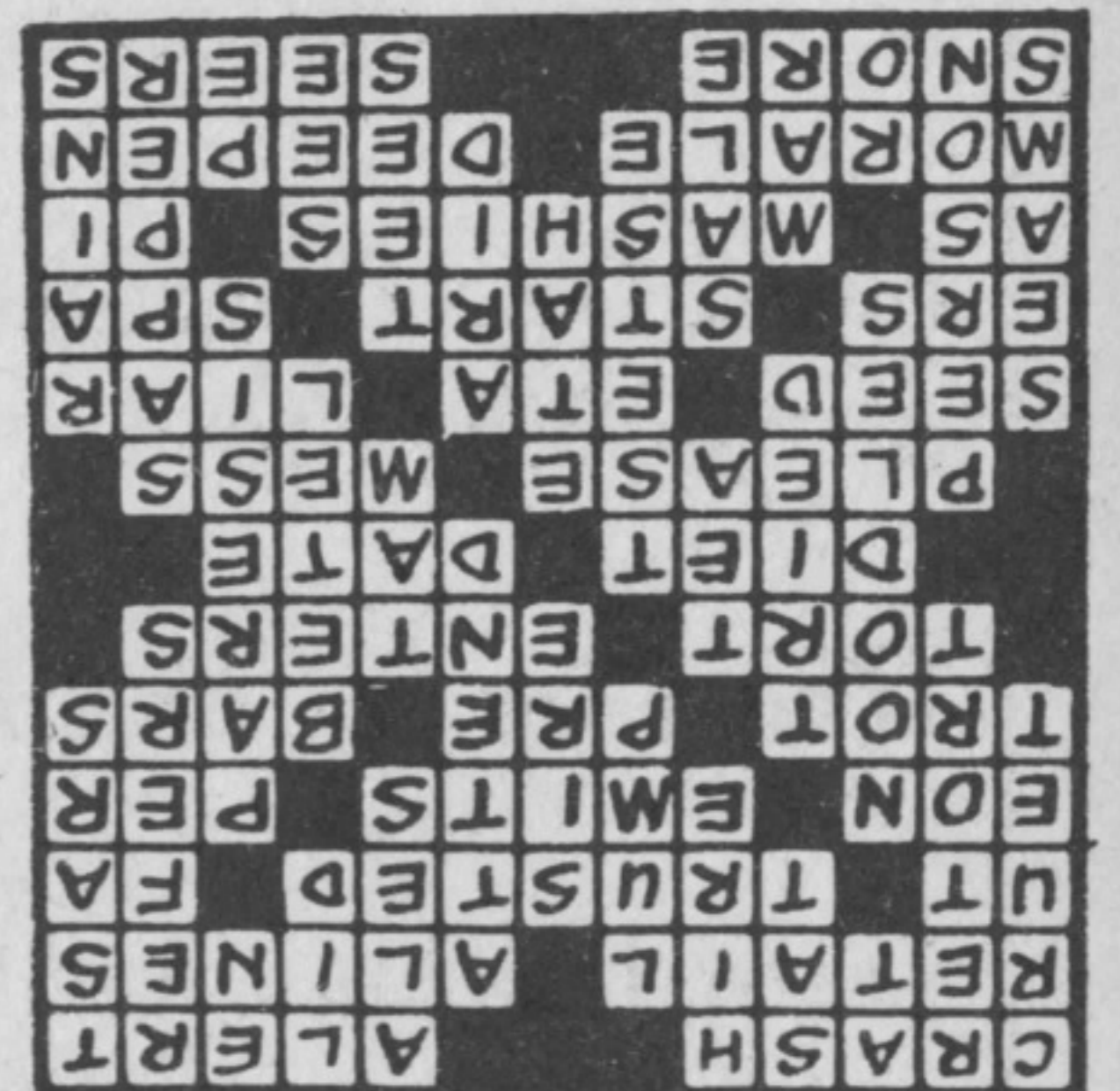
T. Dorland was chairman of the Junior Gardener's Division.

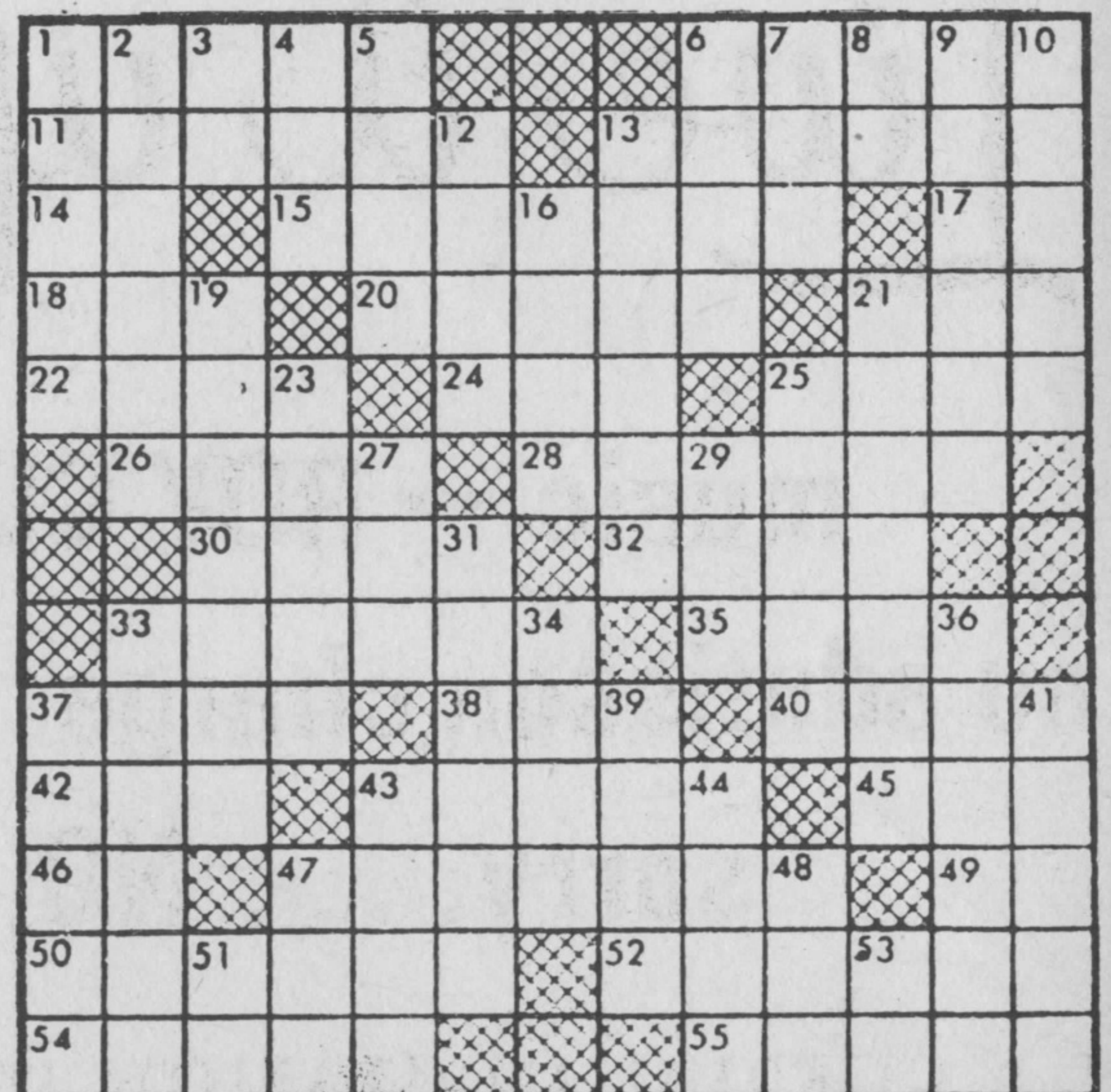
