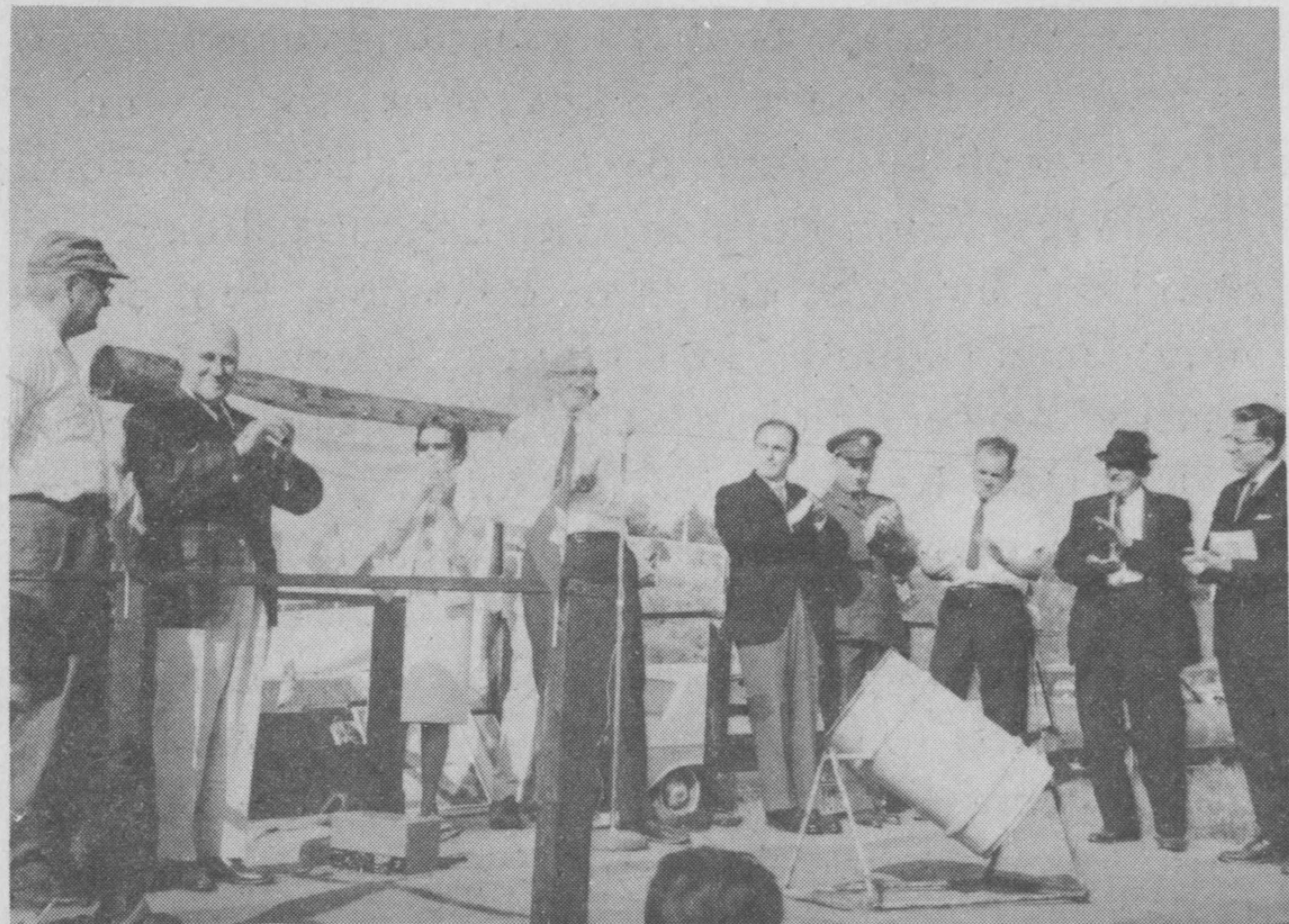
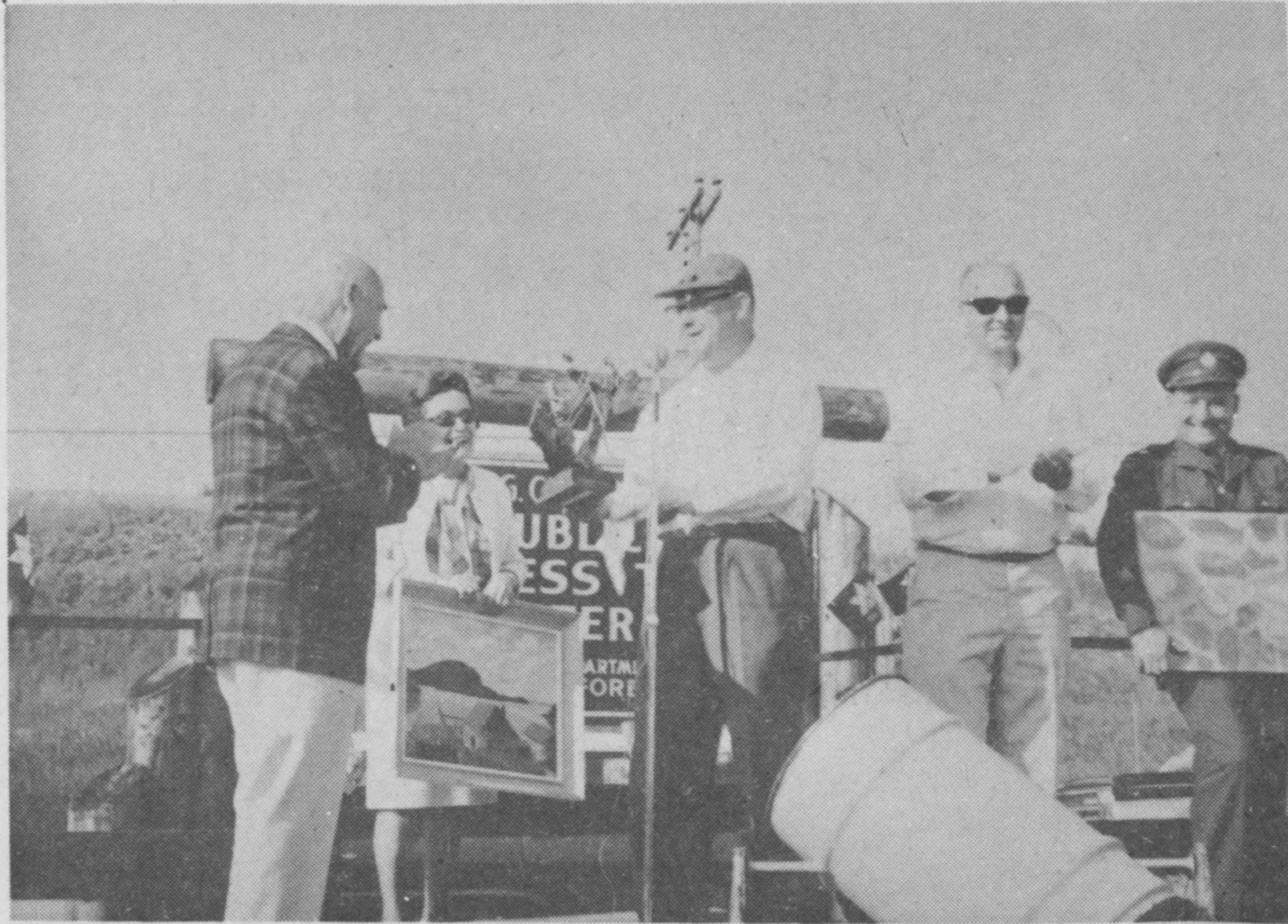


SCENES FROM RECENT PARK DEDICATION CEREMONIES IN ROSSPORT
