Thefts one investigation carried out concerning theft of Highway's Department roadside picnic table which was located through investigation. Lost property -Assistance rendered in attempt to locate valuable rings lost at roadside look-out area near Marathon, by tourists visiting this area. Traffic - Two property damage accidents occurred in Schreiber area resulting in approximately \$1000. damage. No injuries were sustained. 13 charges under the provisions of the Highway Traffic Act were laid as the result of accidents and various offences. A total of 70 vehicles were safety checked and warnings were issued in 29 cases. Assistance to transients was given to 5 persons, in the form of meal tickets through the Schreiber Transient and Welfare Fund.
