Unfinished business included final arrangements to erect a new flag-pole and to contact the Department of Lands and Forests re fire at Jackfish Lake.

Correspondence included a request from the C. G.I.T. for permission to sell candies and a notice from the Canadian Legion re Armistice wreath. A query re bowling rates was referred back to the Recreation Committee.

Permission was given to the C.G.I.T. and it was moved that a wreath be purchased through the Legion.

A letter was read re balance of capital costs now due on the Home for the Aged. An interin Report was presented by the Hydro Department, and monthly reports were presented by the Building Inspector and the Police Deaprtment.

Accounts passed for payments included 62,478.0 62,478.01 Township, 10,035.09 Hydro Department and 512.89 Library.

It was moved by J. Caccamo, seconded by D. Desrosier, that in future, if the press does not
