




22ND. YEAR FOR CANADA SAVINGS BONDS

Twenty-two years separate the ages of Mrs. Sharon Frazer of Willowdale, Ontario, and her year-old daughter, Krista - the same number of years that Canada Savings Bonds have been purchased by Canadians in all walks of life. This year marks the 22nd series of Canada Savings Bonds. Since the first CSB campaign in 1946, Canadians have purchased about \$19-billion worth of the bonds - \$19,060,452,700. to be exact. Of this total, more than \$4-billion worth have been purchased through the Payroll Savings Plan. The 1967 campaign gets underway early in October.
