16 Warnings were issued to motorists regarding infractions of the Traffic Act, and vehicle defects.

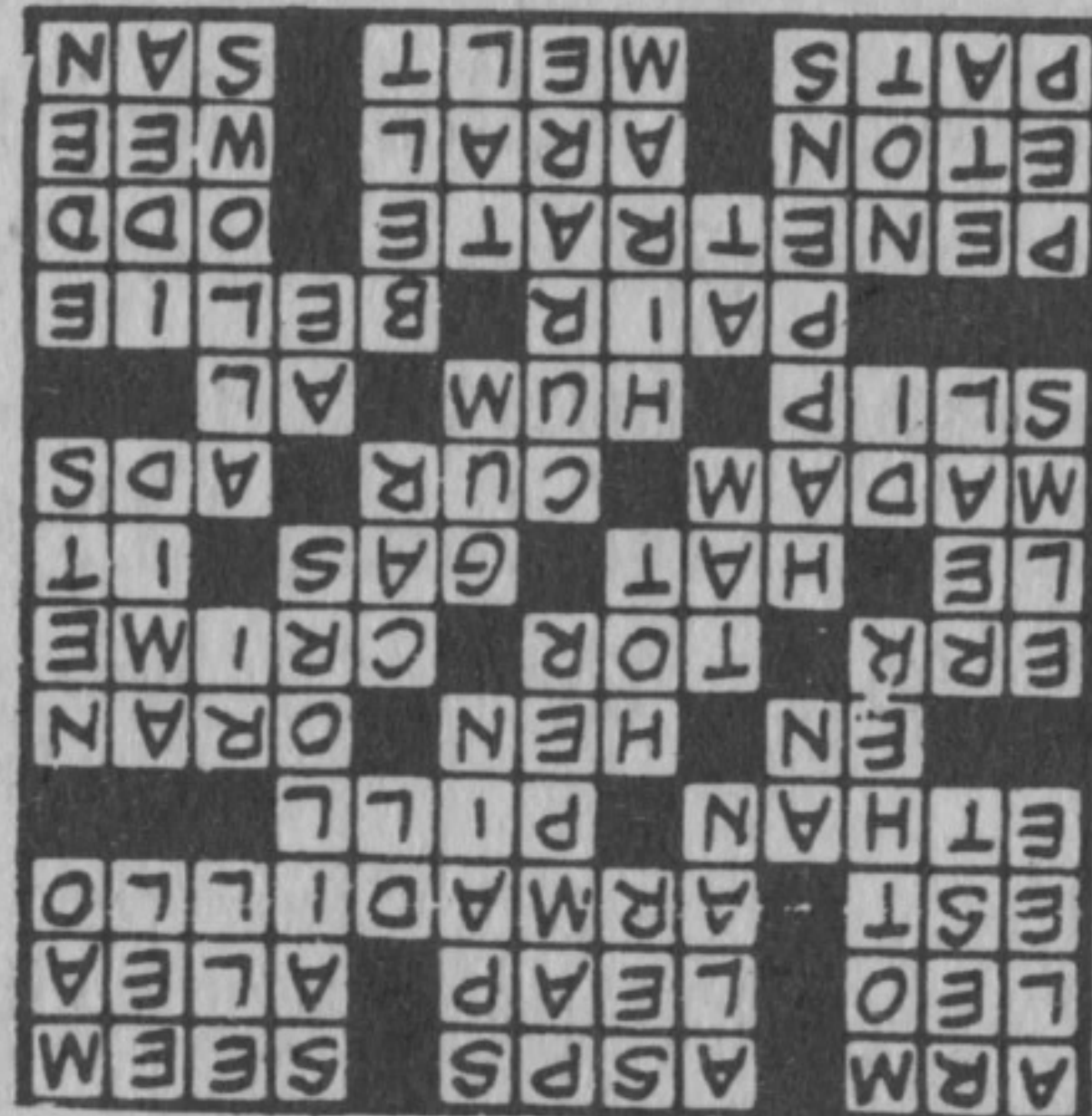

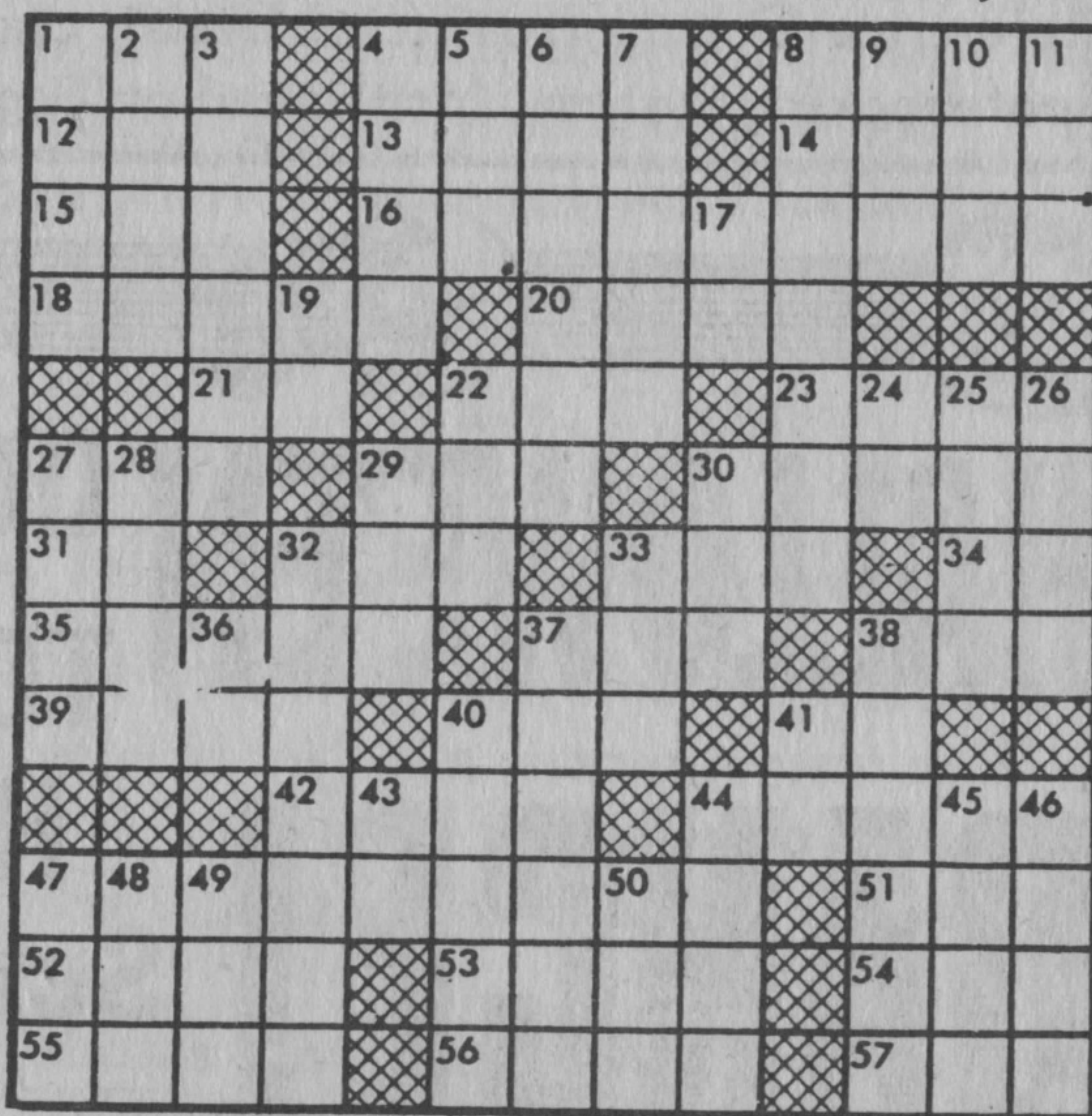
