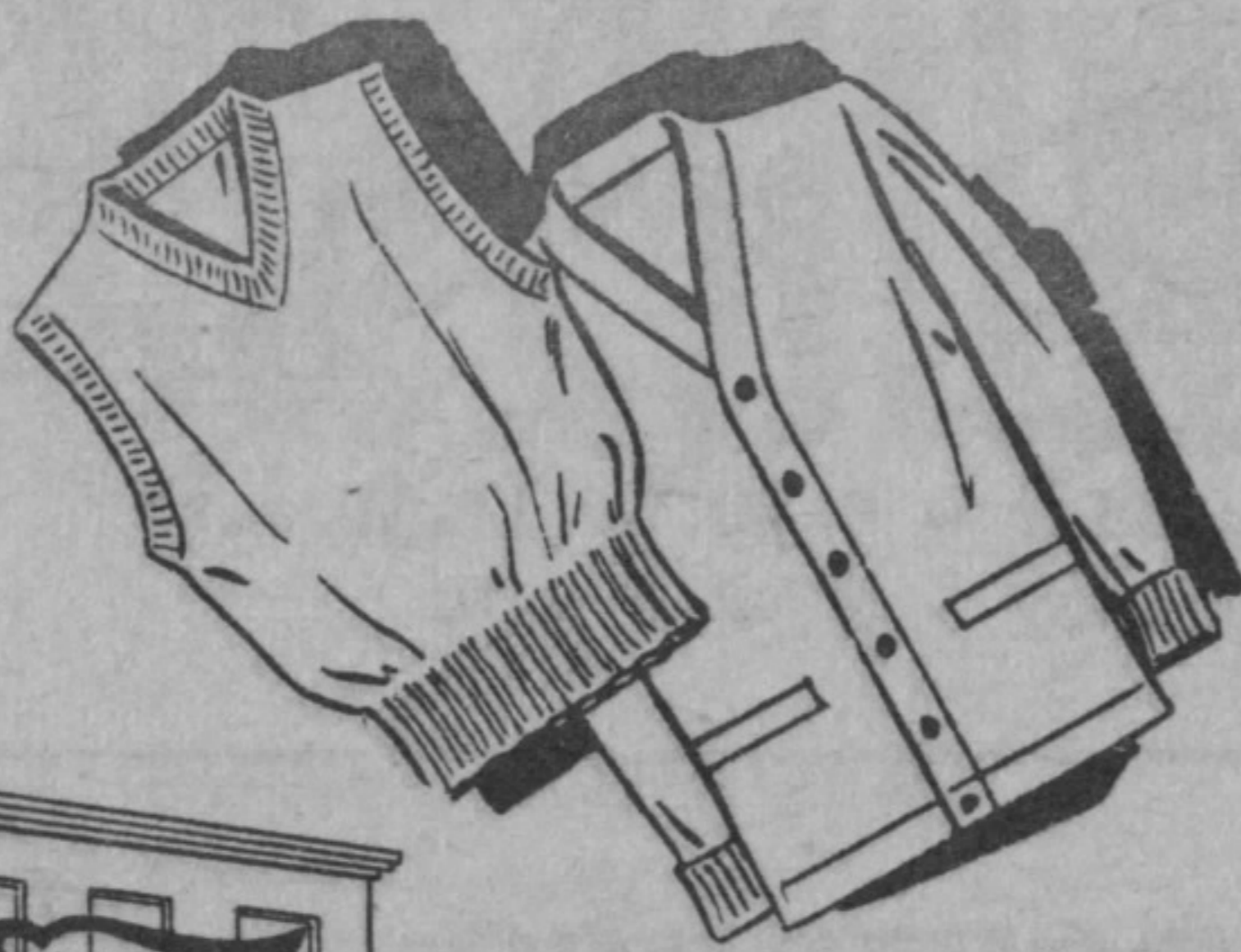

THEATRE GROUP APPEAR AT HIGH SCHOOL

Students of the Terrace Bay High School were privileged Thursday afternoon to have the Crest Theatre Hour Company appear in their auditorium.

The Crest Theatre Hour Company, deriving their name from the fact that their program takes one hour to perform, started in 1963, under Director Barbara Chilcott, who also directed the Crest Theatre in Toronto.

This program, sponsored by the Department of Education of Ontario, was initially intended to dramatize Grade 13 English curriculum. The cast spent 12 weeks in Toronto schools and did so well that the Department decided to put them on tour. The first tour was in 1964, and this is the company's 4th trip around Ontario. They started September 17, 1967 and will end March 15, 1968 with two weeks at home in Toronto for Christmas.

Professor John W. Dodd is in charge of the program Gladys Munnings, Head of English for Ontario also advises.

The Director of the group is Murray Davis. They have played in more than 200 schools, and will have been seen by 100,000 students by the end of the tour.

There are five actors in the group: Mary Barton, Patricia Grant, Henry Havenkamp, Ed Stephenson, and Tony Stephenson. Stage Manager is Len Don Cheff, Company Manager Lawrence Beattie. They carry their own stage settings with them. Their repertoire includes selections from Henry V, Taming of the Shrew and Canadian Songs and Poetry.
