Following two minutes of silence, Greg Morrill led in the Lord's Prayer.

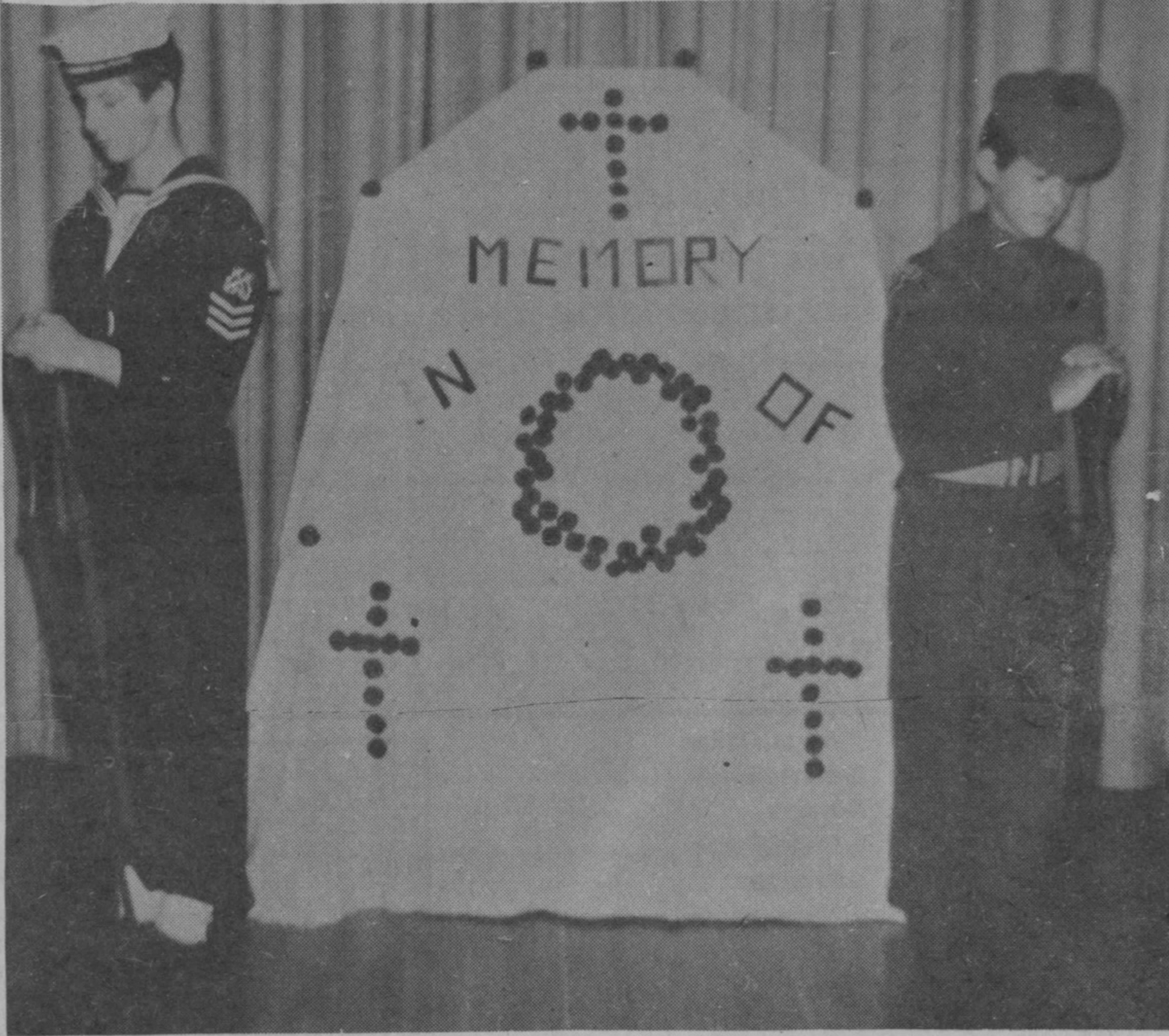
The address was given by W. E. Loree, school principal.
