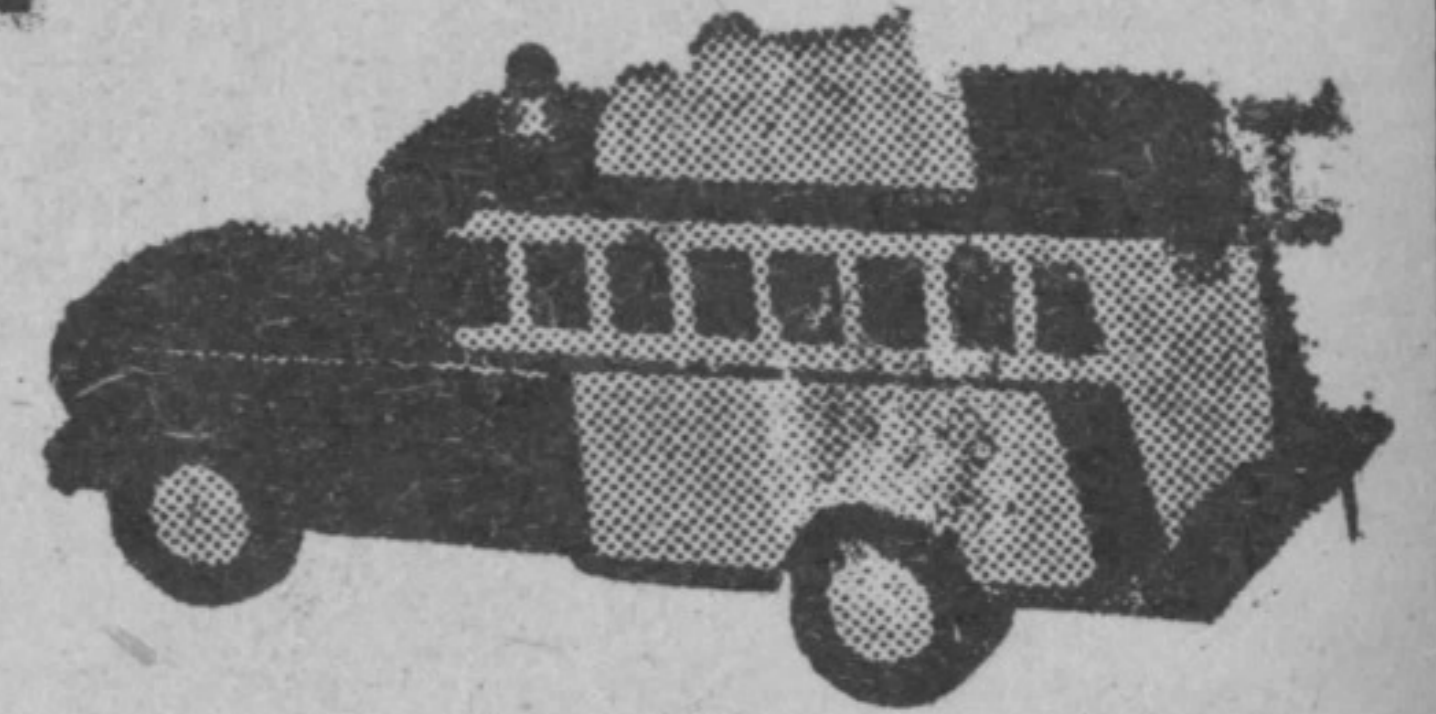

PLEASE NOTE:

No person shall pursuant to the Liquor Control Act:
a) permit drunkenness to take place in any house or any premises of which he is the owner, tenant or occupant; or
b) permit or suffer a person apparently under the influence of liquor to consume any liquor in any house or on

any premises of which the first-named person is owner, tenant or occupant; or
give any liquor to a person apparently under the influence of liquor.

PENALTY:

Every person who is guilty of this offence is liable to a fine of not more than \$1000.00 or to imprisonment for a term of not more than 3 months or both.

PLEASE NOTE:

Vehicles which operate with two skis on the front and a single endless drive belt at the rear, such as the "Ski-Doo" or "Motorized Toboggan" are classed as "Motorcycles", therefore; if operated on a highway it shall be registered as a motorcycle and equipped with proper,brakes, lights, etc., have a licence plate on the rear, and driver must be at least 16 years of age.
