TOWN TOPICS

On Thursday, November 30, in the High School Auditorium, 1st Company Guides received a very informative talk on fires, and were given instructions in the use of fire extinguishers, by George Burns of the Terrace Bay Volunteer Fire Brigade. Locations of said fire extinguishers throughout the School were discussed, at which time a fire hose demonstration took place. A surprise fire drill was given to the Guides, who very aptly cleared the School in less than 2 1/2 minutes, many without coats. They had put into practice their seventh law (obey orders) without a second thought to the cold November night.

On Tuesday evening a group of Guides were privileged to have a demonstration meeting with Mrs. Helen Jartus, Corps Staff Officer, St. John's Ambulance Thunder Bay Corps. Mrs. Jartus talked on safety, first aid, accidents, poisons and child care. Baby sitting was the main subject, and a life-like baby doll was used for mouth-to-mouth respiration practices. The doll was called Resuscitate-Kate and her chest rose when air pressure was induced. The guides, all of baby-sitting age, were amazed and thrilled to demonstrate on Kate.

This lesson was a beginning of a program for the guides to obtain their Child Care Badge. Mrs. Thursa Thompson, R.N. of Terrace Bay will be the instructor for the rest of the course, which will run for approximately 7 weeks. After this, a final test by Mrs. Jartus will conclude the course.
