Sale of Ontario's new licence plates will again test human nature for three full months according to the Ontario Department of Transport. Opening day for purchasing the blue-on-white 1968 passenger, dual purpose and motorcycle plates at all of the 280 issuing offices across the province is Friday, December 1st. Expiry date for 1967 markers will be Thursday, February 29, giving motorists an extra day of grace because it's Leap Year.

Department of Transport officials are again appealing to motorists' common sense in urging them to buy their plates early. There is no reason to get stuck in those last minute line-ups, and there definitely will be no extension beyond the February 29 deadline.

Toronto, Nov.30 - A total of 526 new members have been registered by the Association of Professional Engineers of Ontario at a recent Council meeting. The new members are now accorded the right to use the initials "P.Eng." after their names in connection with any engineering work they undertake.

If sales follow the pattern of past years, more than half of the 2,200,000 licenses for passenger vehicles, dual purpose vehicles and motorcycles will be sold in the last two weeks of February. Those who work in the issuing offices keep hoping that human nature will change. Last year the licenses sold in December amounted to 6.6% of the Total; in January another 17% were sold and the remaining 76.7% were sold from February 1st on. Licenses for commercial motor vehicles, trailers and conversion units will be on sale from March 1st to March 31st.

The 25,000-member Association serves as the licensing body for the engineering profession throughout the Province and also seeks to inform the general public regarding the role played by the professional engineer in Canada's economic development.
