W.M. Stella Brown thanked the installing officers.

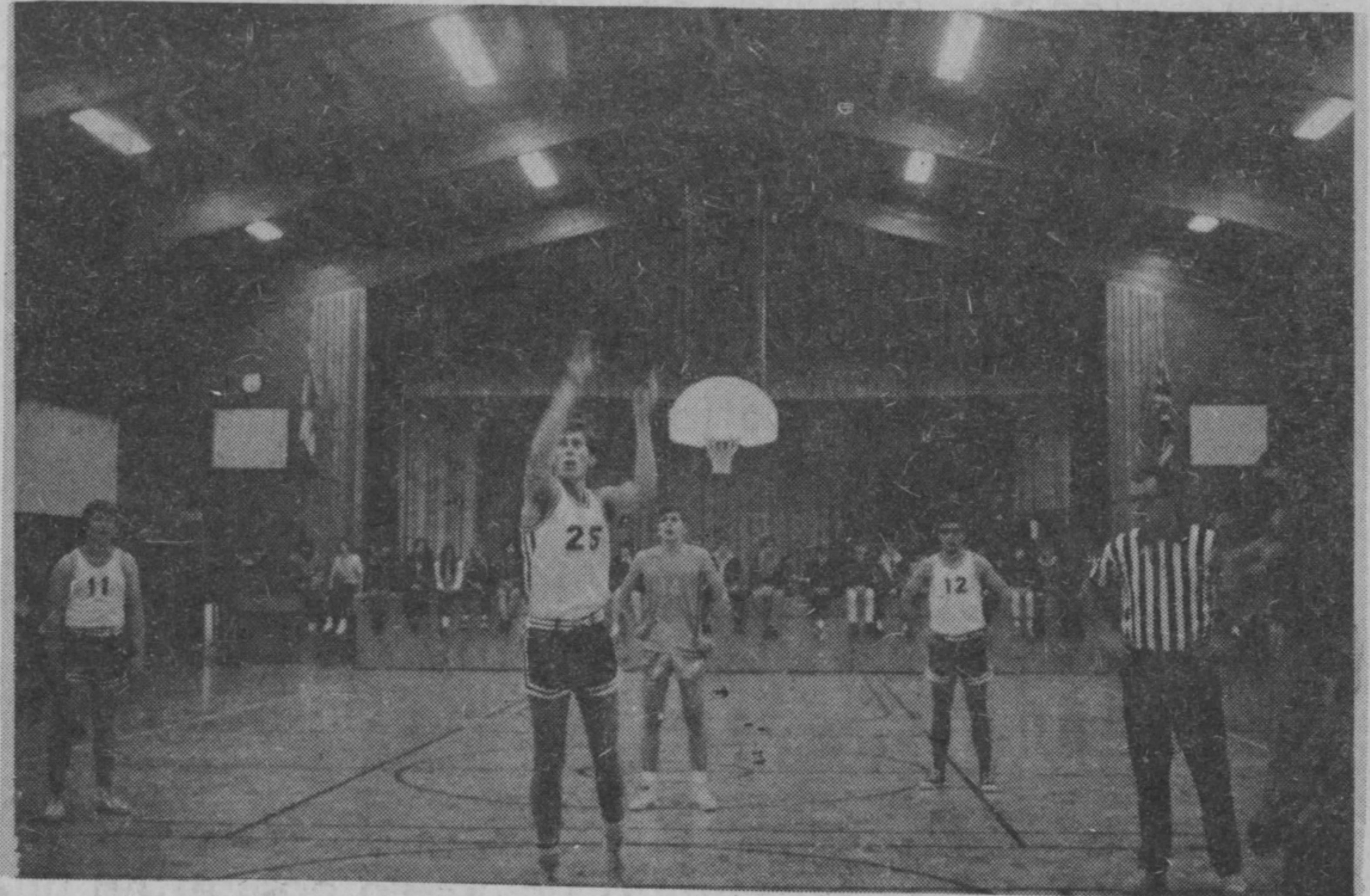

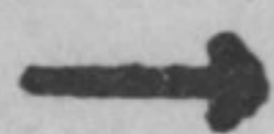
