advising Council their portion would be \$2000.00. This proposal will be passed on to the 1973 Council.

The Mental Health Association of Ontario requested that Council make a donation to help carry on their important work. A grant cf \$25.00 was approved.

A letter of congratulations to the Reeveelect Roy Bray was received from the Mayor of Thunder Bay, Saul Laskin.

A letter from the Improvement District of Manitouwadge to the Lake Superior Board of Education was read, suggesting that determination of membership for the Separate School

Trustees of the Lake Superior Board was in fact in error, and that instead of 4 trustees elected at large, allocation should have been by equalized assessment, in each municipality. The result would be that Manitouwadge should have had 2 of 4 members as Trustees, Terrace Bay and Schreiber one each. Manitouwadge has applied to the District Judge to have the initial determination set aside, and a new determination prepared. If a new determination is in fact made, it will apply in respect to the election next following such determination.

Minutes of the McCausland Hospital Board of Governors meeting were read.

Accounts passed for payment were as follows Township - 41,182.74; Hydro - 13,643.58; Library - 1,358.53; Recreation Committee -9,394.55.

A letter from the Terrace Bay Ski Club requested Council to review their suggestions of last year, regarding the use of snow machines on and around the Ski hill area.
