Terrace Bay Town Council held their first meeting of the New Year, with Reeve Cavanaugh in the chair and all councillors present.

Minutes were read by Clerk Hanley and accepted. Accounts passed for payment were as follows; Township - \$6,614.86; Hydro - \$6,647.42; Library -\$512.75.

Members of the present library board, including Mr John Brooks, Mr. R. Roberts, Mrs. K. Angus, Mr. H. Ratchford, and Mrs. M. Dorland were re-appointed.

Council held considerable discussion regarding the matter of dogs being allowed to run at large. This situation is not good and drastic steps may have to be taken to correct it. Packs of dogs are frightening small school children. Consideration is being given to increasing the fun for any dog owner who allows his dog to run at large. By-Law No.129 states that any dog running at large, not on a leash, or unattended by a competent person, may be seized and impounded, and killed, whether before or after impounding.
