

1968 TAX PAYMENTS  
TOWNSHIP OF TERRACE BAY

INTERIM BILL - PAYABLE FEBRUARY 27th, 1968

FINAL BILL - PAYABLE JUNE 24th and SEPTEMBER 24th, 1968

At a meeting of Council held on Tuesday, January 9th, by-law #200, being a by-law to authorize a pre-levy of taxes for the year 1968, was given final approval.

Again this year there will be two Tax Bills issued - an Interim Bill, which will be sent out during the latter part of January, and the Final Bill, which will be mailed out in May.

The Interim Bill will amount to approximately one-third of the year's taxes (based on last year's requirements) and is payable on or before February 27, 1968

The Final Bill will be mailed during the latter part of May and will be payable in two (equal) instalments- approximately June 24th and September 24, 1968.

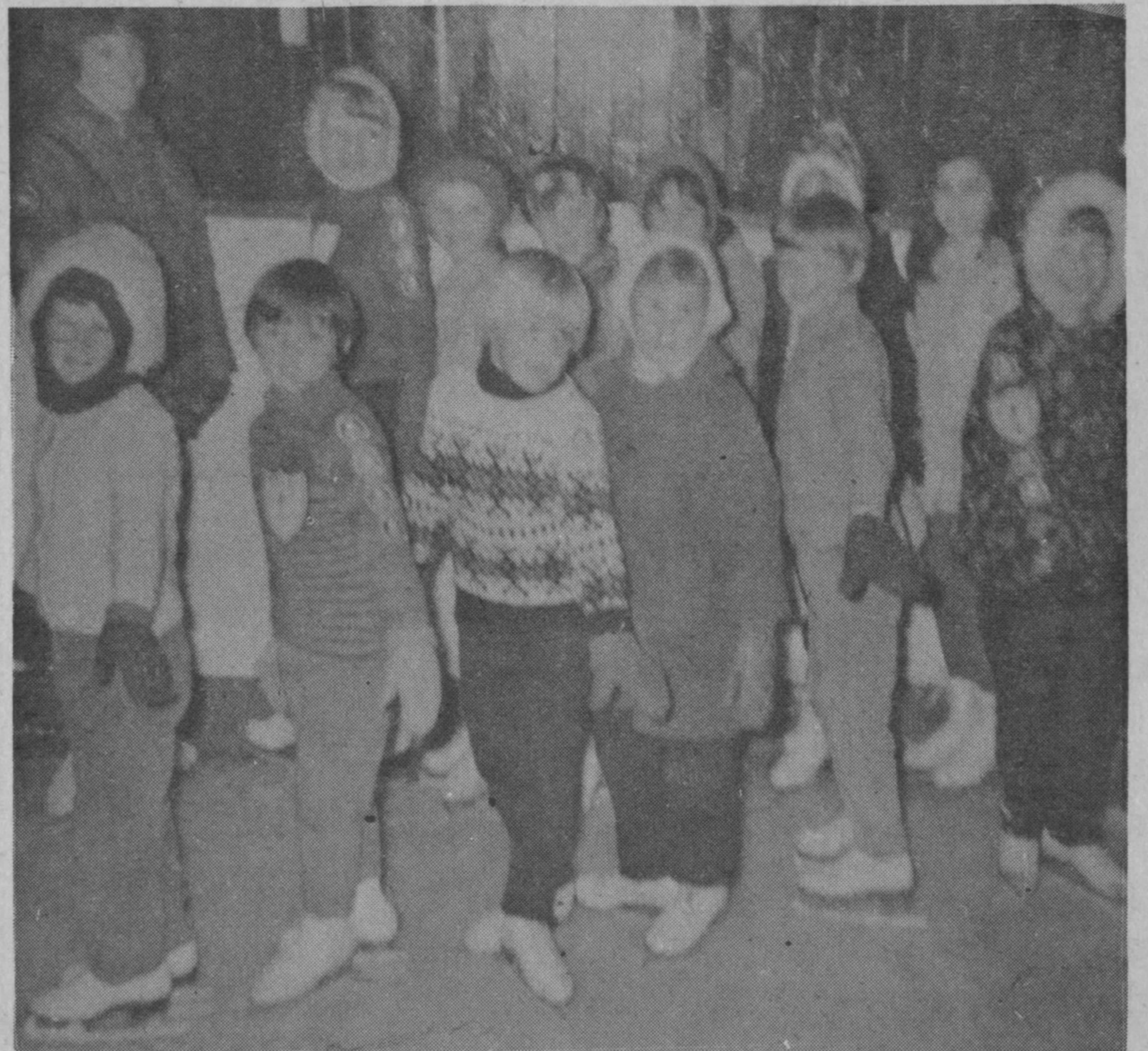
