He mentioned three other areas as projects for 1968 - re-organizing the Senior Sunday School, Senior Choir, and a Paint-the-Church Fund.

Mr. Anderson thanked everyone who had given their time and help, during his term of office. He stated that he felt it a privilege to be able to work in the Church as Chairman of the Board. He also voted a word of appreciation to Mr. Husser, who has done an excellent job in all respects.
