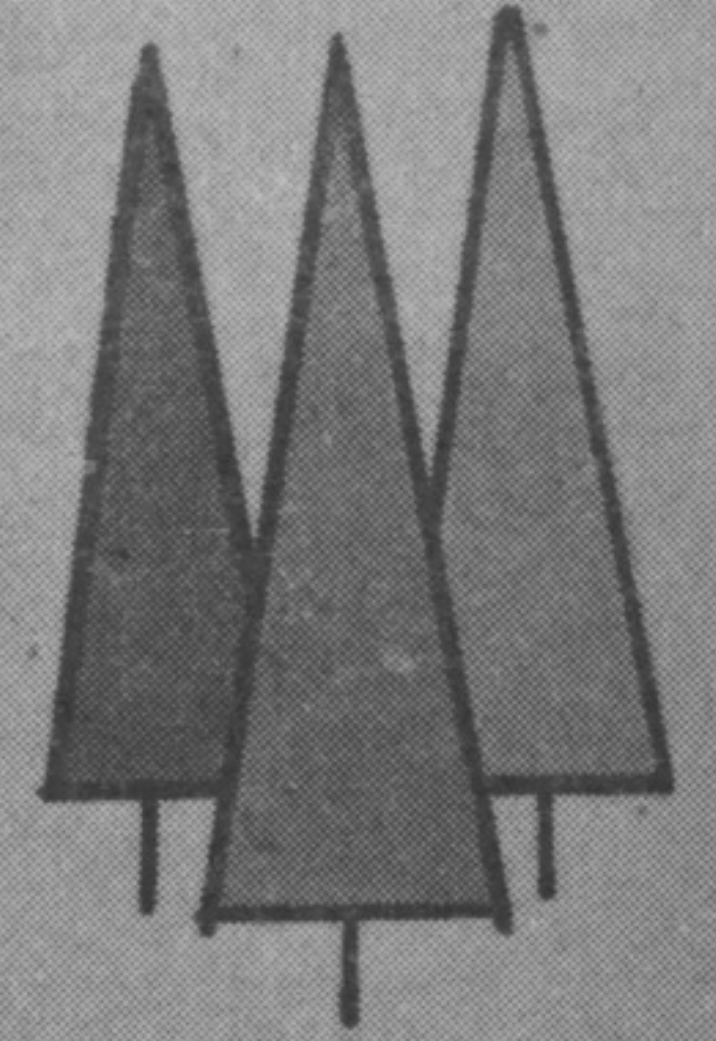

3.30 to 5.30 (open skating)

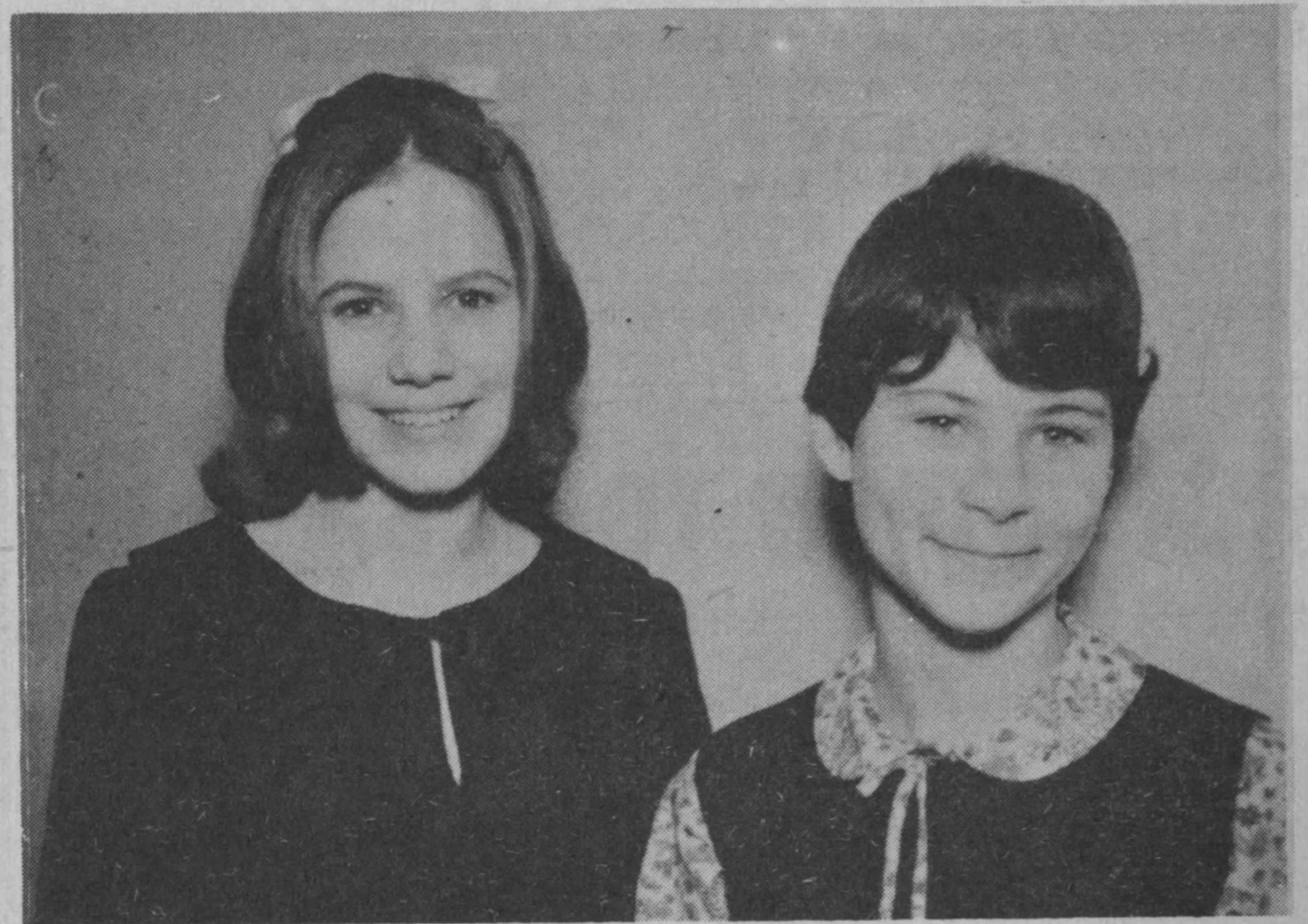
Fridays - 7.00 to 9.30 p.m.
