ART COURSE PLANNED FOR MARCH 22, 23, 24th

The Terrace Bay Recreation Association, in co-operation with the community programs service, Ontario department of education is sponsoring an art course on drawing and portrait painting, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, March 22, 23 and 24th in Meeting Room #3.

The course will be conducted by Harold Norrington a graduate of drawing and painting courses - Ontario College of Art. Mr. Norrington has had various teaching experiences and attended the Community programs service district leadership courses held at the University of Guelph in '65 and '66. Also an oil painting course at Geneva Park. He exhibited his work in the Canadian Society of Graphic Artists in 1967 at Ottawa and Toronto. Also at the

Society of Canadian Painter-Etchers and Engravers in 1965 and 1966.

The course will provide instruction in gesture drawing; contour drawing, portrait drawing with oils on canvas or panels. It will open to all interested persons wishing to pursue drawing and portrait painting. Registration fee has been set at \$5.00 per candidate. Enrolment will be limited to the first 20 applicants.
