Tentative plans were made to hold a Father's Day Tea.

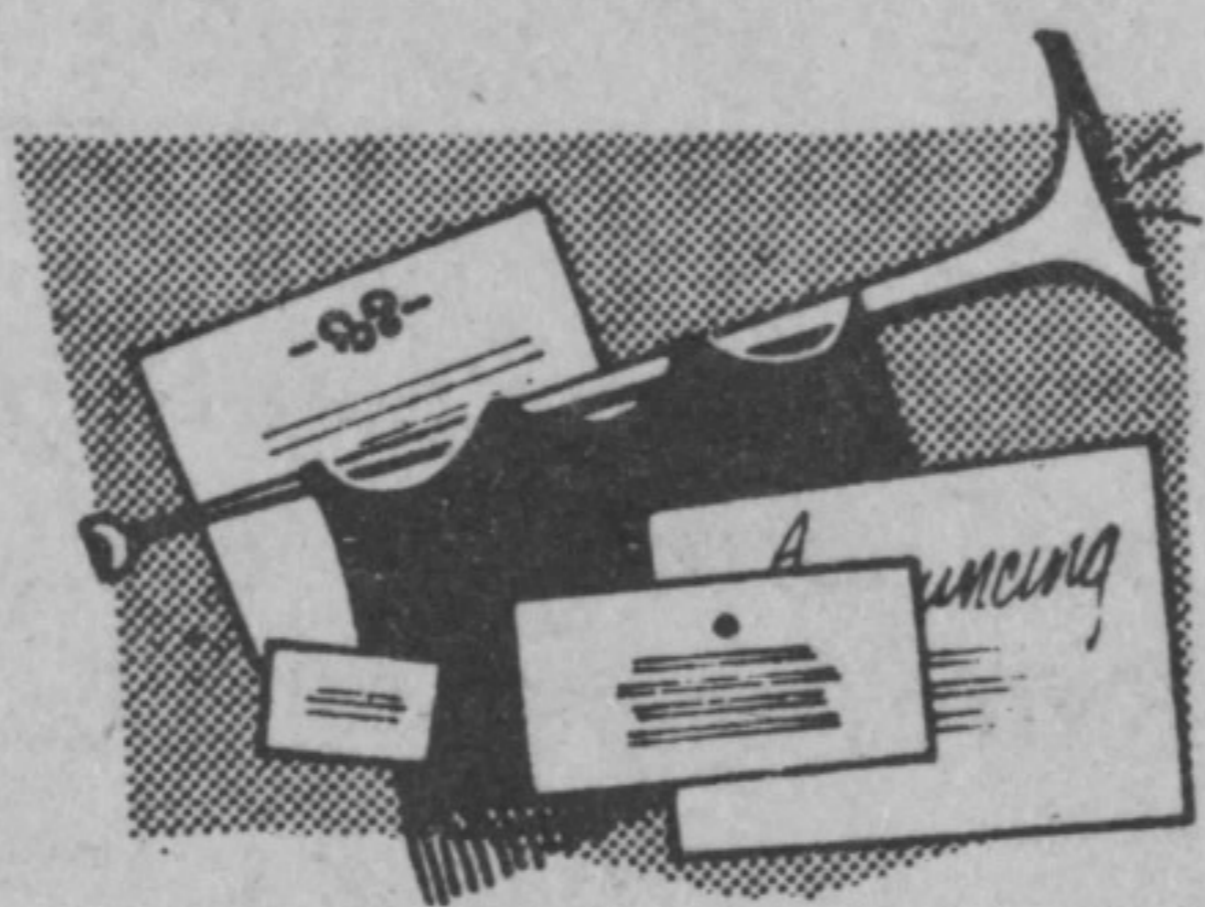
A correction in the winners named for the Home Bingo - J. Rochon, and not P. Rochon, was one of the winners.
