
PENNER STARTS CAMPAIGN IN AREA

After a special meeting with Prime Minister
Trudeau and Liberal Party President, Senator Stanbury in Toronto last Saturday, Keith Penner, newly elected Liberal Candidate in the Thunder Bay Riding, will start his official campaign in the eastern part of his vast riding. Penner will be in Geraldton on the 21st, Manitouwadge on the 22nd, Schreiber on the 23rd, and in Marathon on the 24th.

One of Penner's reasons for meeting with the Liberal Party executive is to appeal for more support from the national organization so that he can do a more effective job of traveling around and meeting people in this 115,000 sq. mile riding. "As it now stands", said Mr. Penner, "the Liberal Party in Thunder Bay must depend on the individual support of Liberal Associations in each of the small towns in the Riding. The Community Associations in turn depend almost entirely on membership sales at one or two dollars each. Membership has been growing

rapidly in Thunder Bay, but we still expect that extra funds will have to come from National head-quarters if I am to meet people in every corner of the riding."

"For too long," Mr. Penner concluded, " the smaller towns of Northwestern Ontario have been dominated by members from outside our riding. If elected I would act immediately to make representation more effective for the individual towns by arranging direct telephone contact and by utilizing whatever government air service exists to travel throughout the riding. During this election, I hope to make maximum the number of personal contacts with people in their own communities, rather than depending on the one-way communication of radio and T.V."

"Effective Representation" in fact will be the theme of Mr. Penner's campaign. Mr. Penner has been very effective in bringing a number of important contributions to Dryden, through his work as Member of the Town Council, Chairman of the profitable Dryden Telephone Commission, Chairman of the Centennial Committee and President of the Kinsmen Club, and he believes his experience in these activities should be of great assistance in helping him, if successful on June 25th, to be a more effective M.P.
