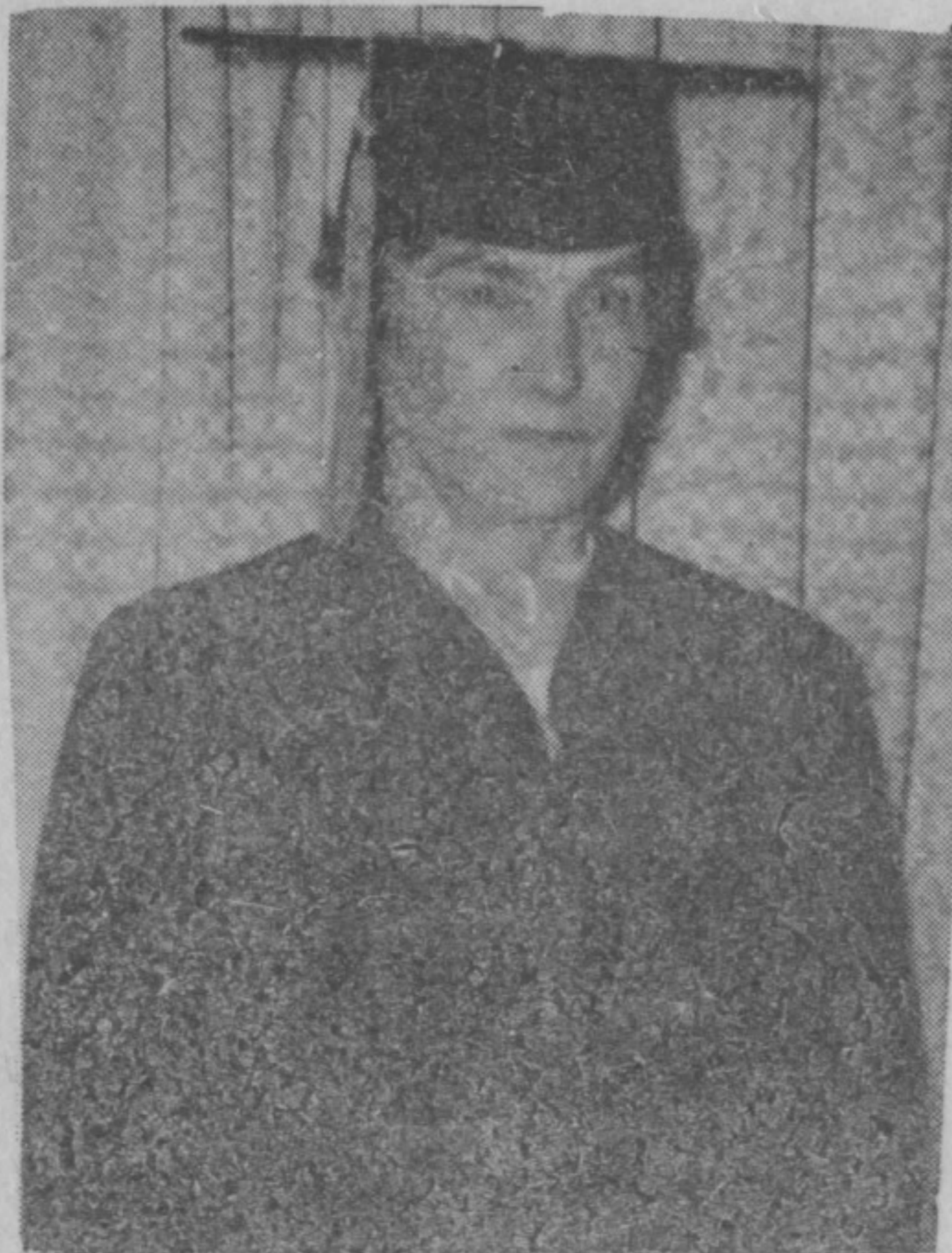

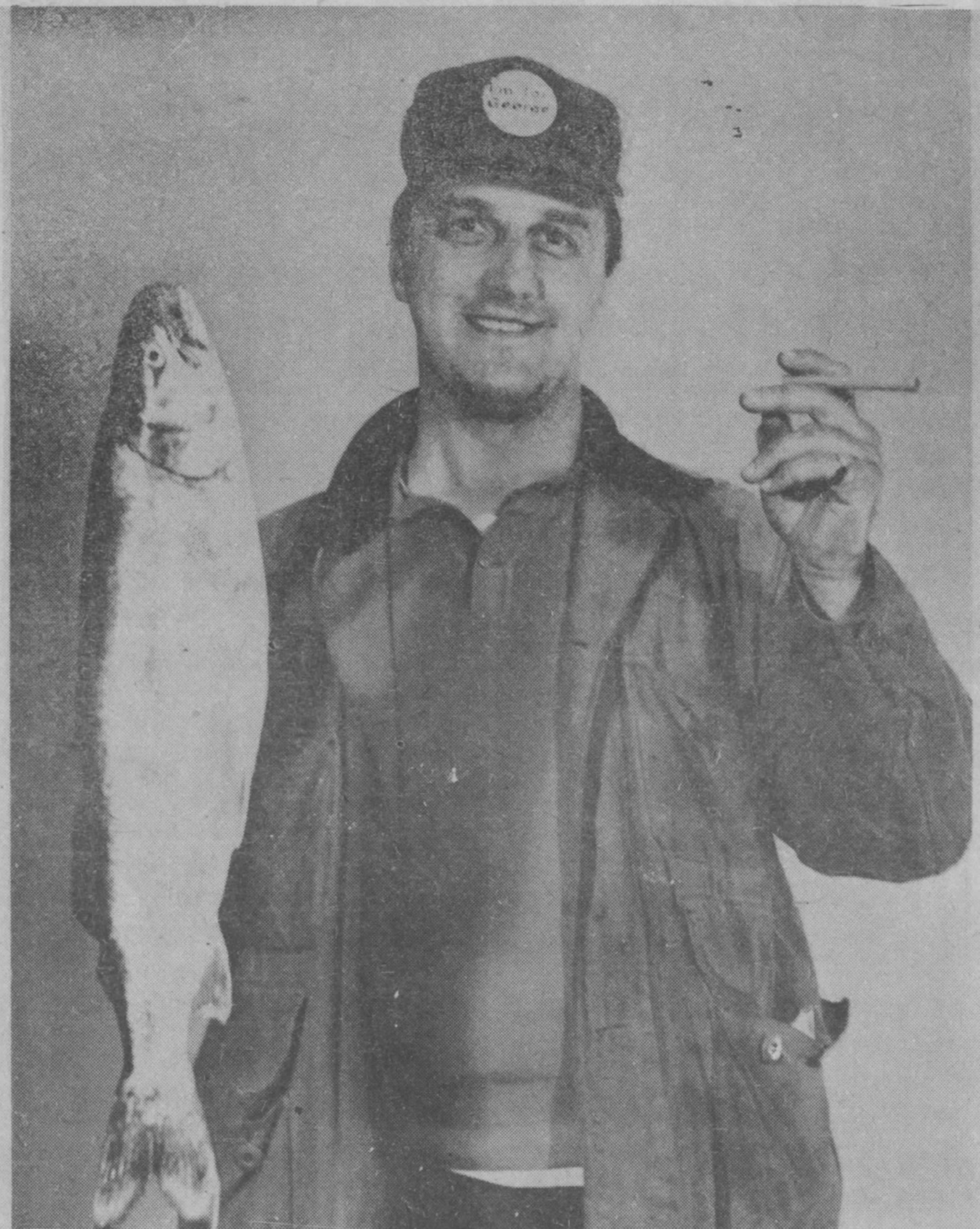

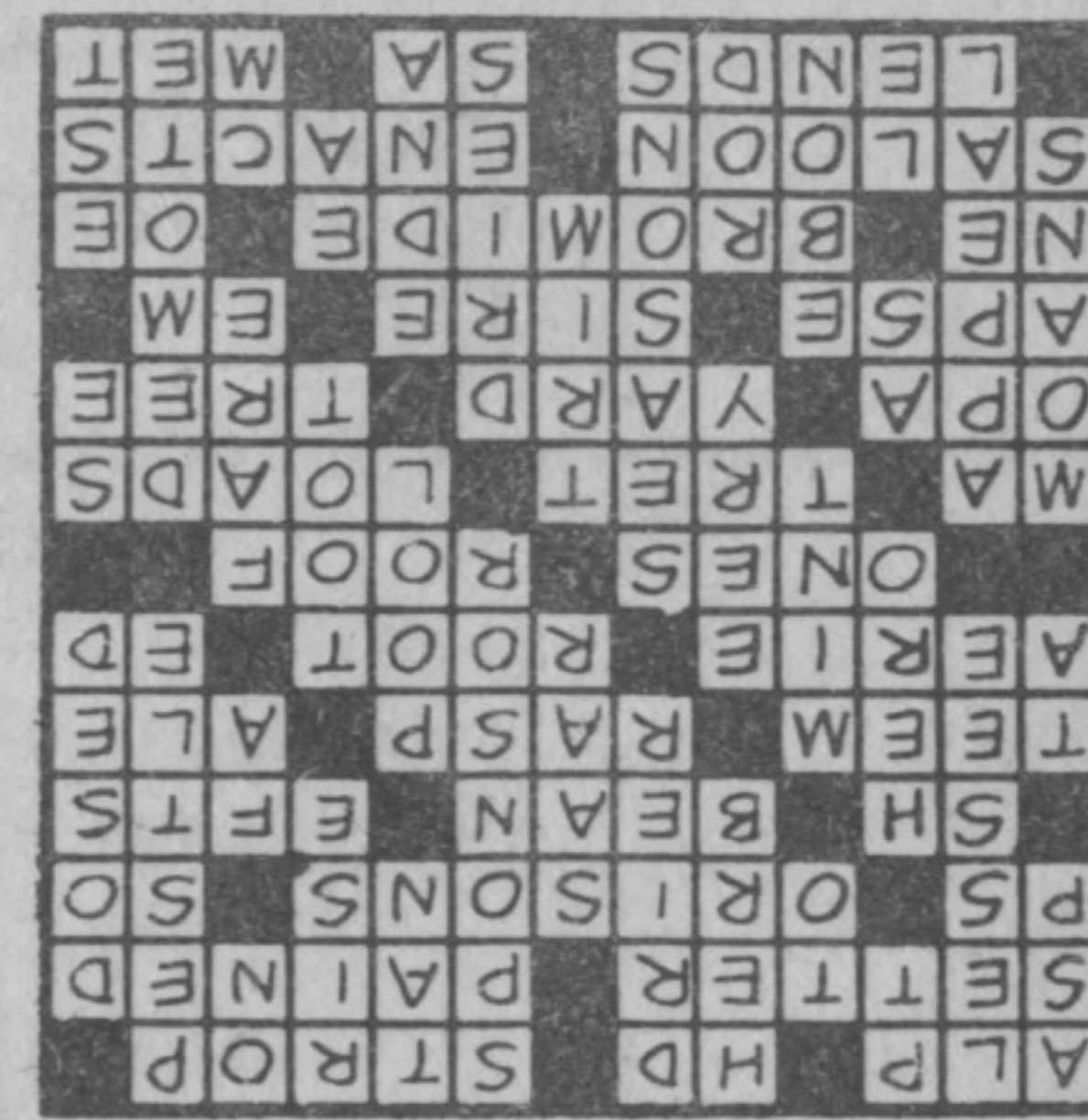
GOLF NEWS
