Bare-headed motorcyclists will be banned from Ontario's highways September 1st, when the change in Highway Traffic Act, requiring operators of motorcycles AND passengers to wear helmets comes into ettect. Helmets must conform to new standards. They must carry the monogram of the CSA testing laboratories. For the convenience of motorcyclists, helmets now in use will be permitted until December 31st, 1969, provided that they have a hard smooth outer shell and are lined with protective padding or fitted with other energy-absorption material. The helmet must be strongly attached to a strap designed to fasten under the chin, and the helmet must not be damaged. IT'S BETTER TO BE SAFE THAN SORRY!
