ONTARIO PROVINCIAL POLICE REPORT

During the past week the Schreiber Detachment of the Ontario Provincial Police investigated one motor vehicle accident, which resulted in approximately \$70 damage with one subject being injured.

From September 29 to October 5, 1968, members

of this Detachment patrolled 2,554 miles of highways and logged 152 working hours.

There were 9 persons charged under the Highway Traffic Act; 24 persons were warned and 65 vehicles were given safety checks.

There was one complaint of an alleged assault which was cleared. One stolen vehicle was recovered by members of this Detachment. The vehicle had been stolen from Sarnia, Ontario. There were two domestic complaints reported and later cleared.

There were two liquor seizures in which three charges were laid under the Liquor Control Act.
