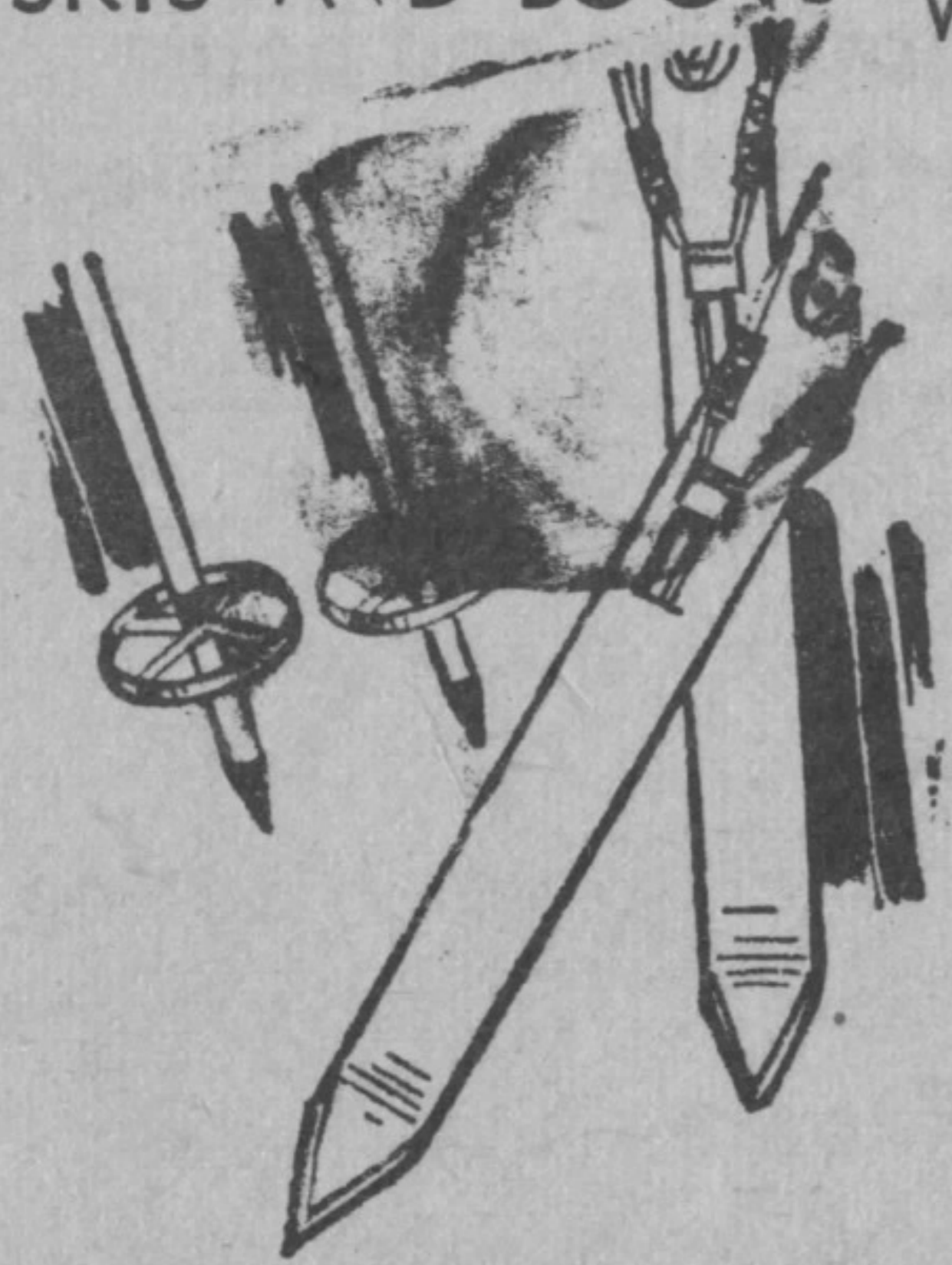

PRESS RELEASE FROM JACK STOKES

Jack Stokes, M.P.P., attended the organizational meeting of the newly formed Nipigon Fish and Game Association on November 8th. He says "It was obvious from the multitude of questions asked that little is known by our citizens about the Land Inventory and open and deferred zones in the Geraldton Forest District." In a letter to District Forester Eric Gage he says, "No doubt you are aware of the dismay and consternation of these people who were told to vacate hunting cabins and then to have them burned without sufficient explanation. It would be fair to say that many were of the opinion that local residents were being dealt with in an arbitrary manner while non residents and fly-in tourists were given special treatment. They were disturbed about lodges on Simpson treatland which is used by fly-in operators and located on what they believe to be Crown Land.

I urge you with all the strength at my command to cease the destruction of these hunting and fishing cabins until sportsmen have had an opportunity to explain their positions and representatives of your Department have made every effort to explain government policy.
