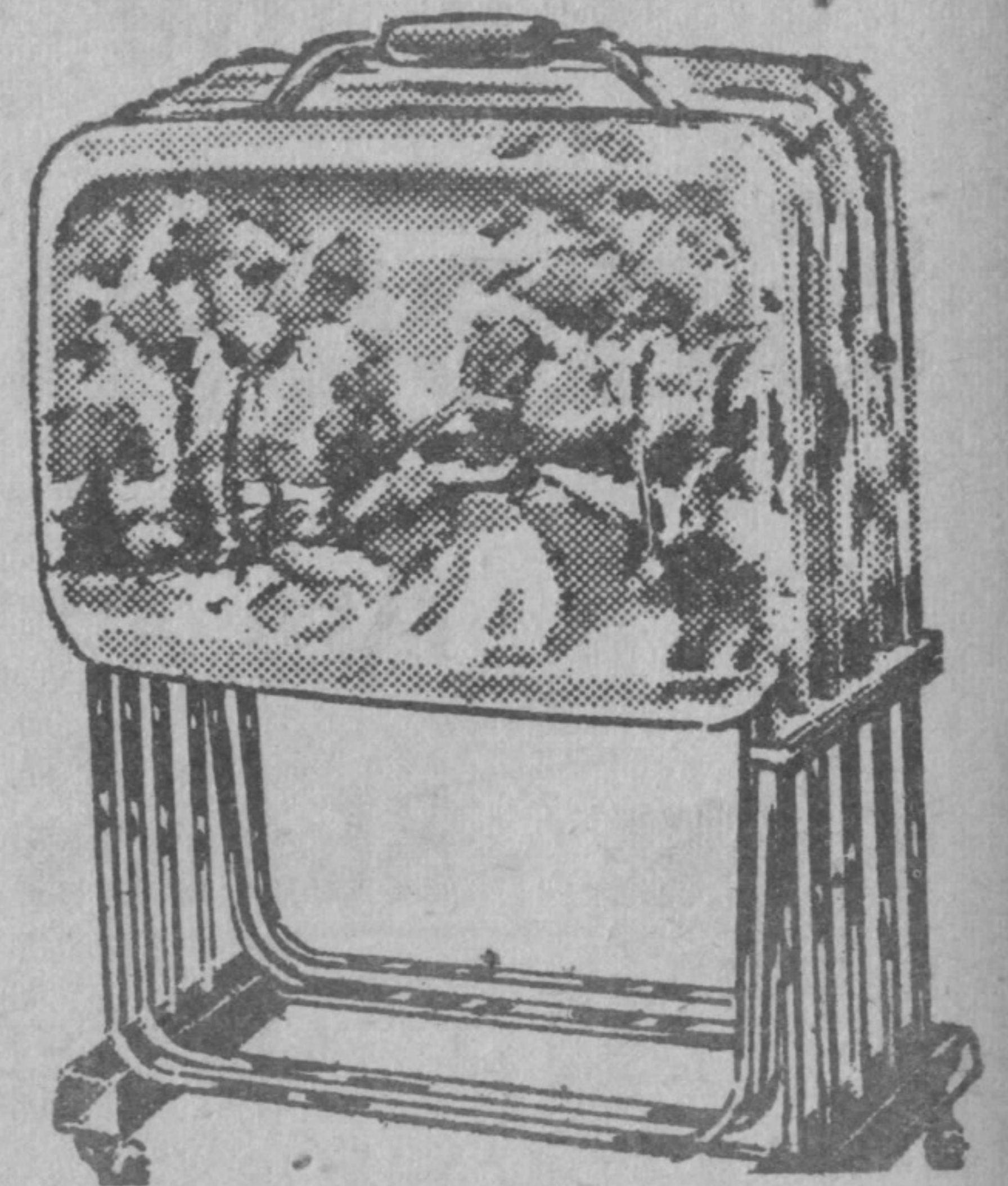

The Toronto Board of Education voted last night to allow a parent group use of Whitney Public School on Rosedale Heights Drive for film shows on Saturday afternoons.

The Board waived the standard \$28 fee for the school's use after trustee Barry Lowes argued that neighbourhood theatres no longer show films suitable for children.

Mr. Lowes, Chairman of the Metro School Board and a strong advocate of community use of school facilities, said the Toronto Board should actively encourage parent groups to use the city's other schools.
