**NOTICE -** The Roxy Theatre will be closed on Christmas Eve. There will be one show on New Years Eve at 7 to 9 p.m.

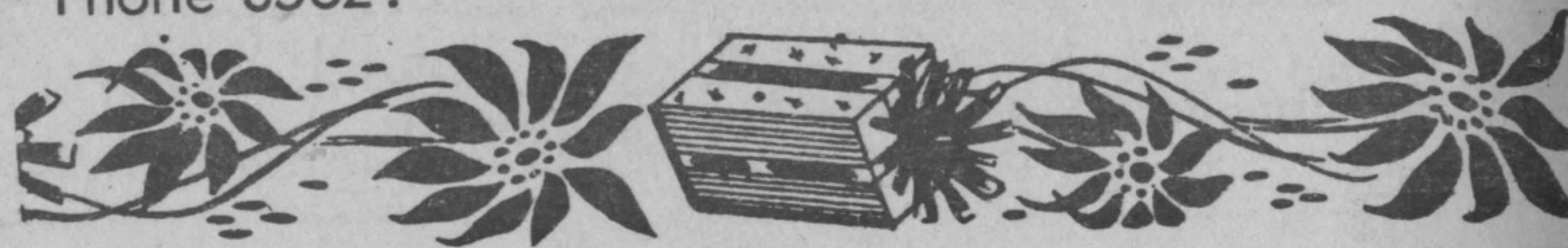
**SANTA'S MAIL BOX**
