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of the container with household cement, make attractive trimming materials for glass mould candles. Other attractive trims can include appropriate pictures, decals, flowers, butterflies, Christmas decor.

When candles have burned down too far to be attractive, they can be loosened from the container by placing in a refrigerator for about an hour. The candle can then be readily removed and remelted and used for refilling the mould.

EASY TO MAKE CANDLES IN GLASS CONTAINERS

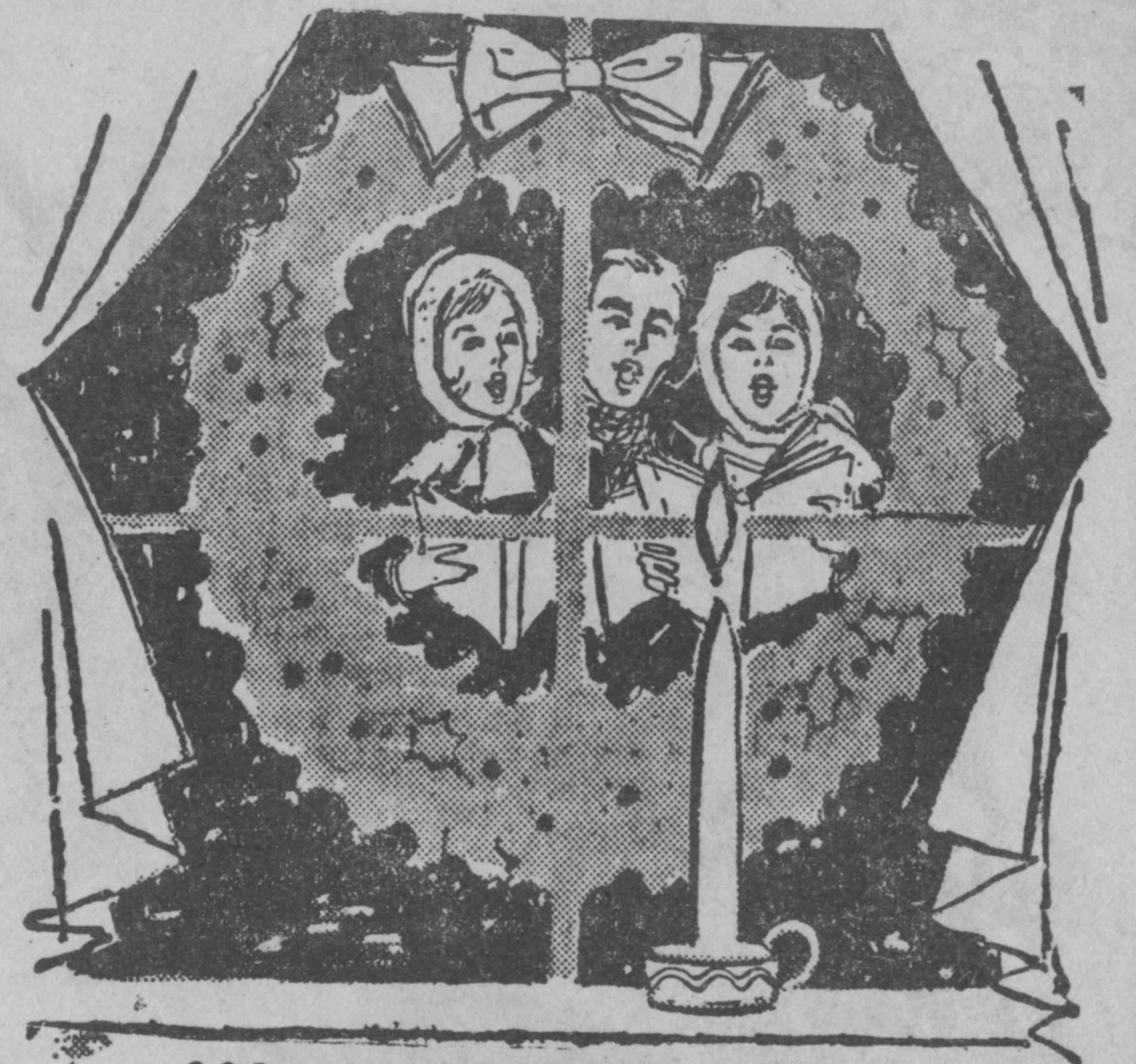
Candles in glass containers, highly suitable for decorating your home, are discussed in this article on candle making.

Utensils and materials required include the basic candle making equipment, plus a metal wick clip, metal core wicking, suitable glass mould, and decorations chosen to enhance the room's decor.

Metal core wicking should be used for candles in glass containers since the wick retains its shape when hot wax is poured around it and it helps conduct the heat away from the glass when burning.

Prepare your work area by covering with newspaper and set wax to melt in a double boiler. Thread metal core wicking through the hole in the wick clip and secure wick by pressing down prongs of clip into a small piece of plasticine, centering it carefully in the bottom of the mould. Then pour a little liquid wax into the mould sufficient to cover it, and hold it securely in place. Place a metal rod across the top centre of the glass mould and wind the wicking around the rod several times. Pull wick tight, and make sure that it is centred, slowly pour hot wax into the mould. Puncture and refill air holes as necessary.
