

SCHREIBER HYDRO CUSTOMERS PLEASE NOTE PAYMENT REGULA-TIONS

(1) No prompt discount shall be allowed unless the bill is paid on or before the last discount date.

(2) When consumers bill is not paid by the 5th day of the month following billing the service shall be discontinued without notice and the service shall not be given again until payment is made in full, including a charge of \$3.00 for cost of reconnection.
