


BOTTOM PHOTO - HALLWAY TO THE SHOPS



HYDRO STRIKE CONTINUES INTO THIRD WEEK

Ontario Hydro's management and supervisory staff across the northwestern part of the Province has been called on in the past two weeks to operate the Commission's resources and facilities throughout the Region, including the 13 generating stations which provide electricity for Ontario's homes, farms and

industries.

Despite the hit-and-run strike by the 400 members of Local 1000 of the Canadian Union of Public Employees in the Region, skeletal crews of supervisory personnel have been able to maintain electrical service without interruption of power. All parts of Northwestern Region have been hit by the strike on at least two occasions. - Terrace Bay February 7th and 17th.
