

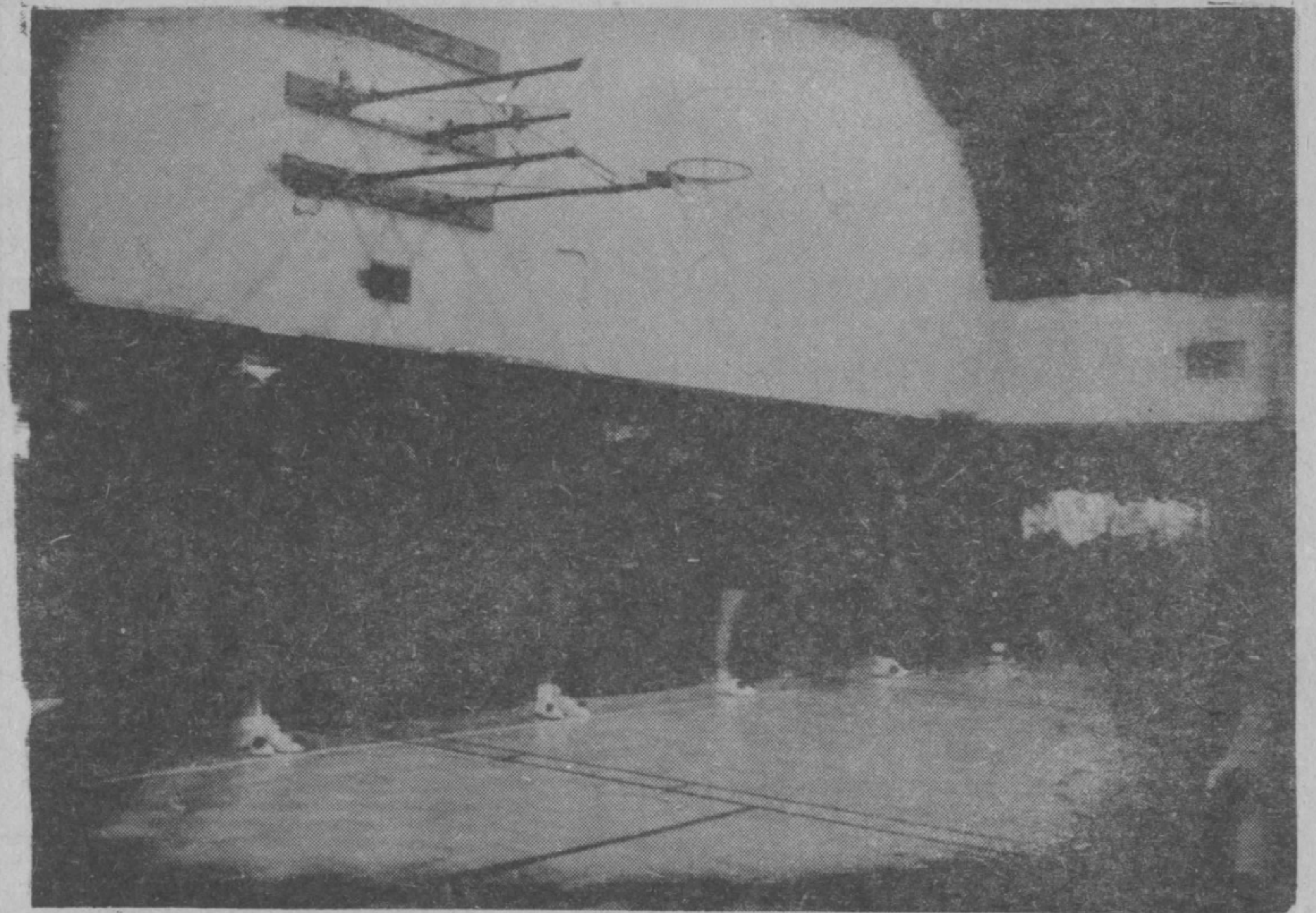
TERRACE BAY HIGH
