OF TREES AND MEN - from Dept. of Lands & Forests Newsletter
Trees and humans share a rather interesting growth phenomenon - size increase, in relation to size, is greatest shortly after life begins and thereafter steadily decreases. Humans triple their birth weight, approximately, in the first year, add only 25 per cent in the second year, and drop to an increase of less than 20 per cent in the third year. Spruce seedlings show a more spectacular relative growth rate, but the relationship is similar: fifty times the first year, ten times the second year and five times the third year.
