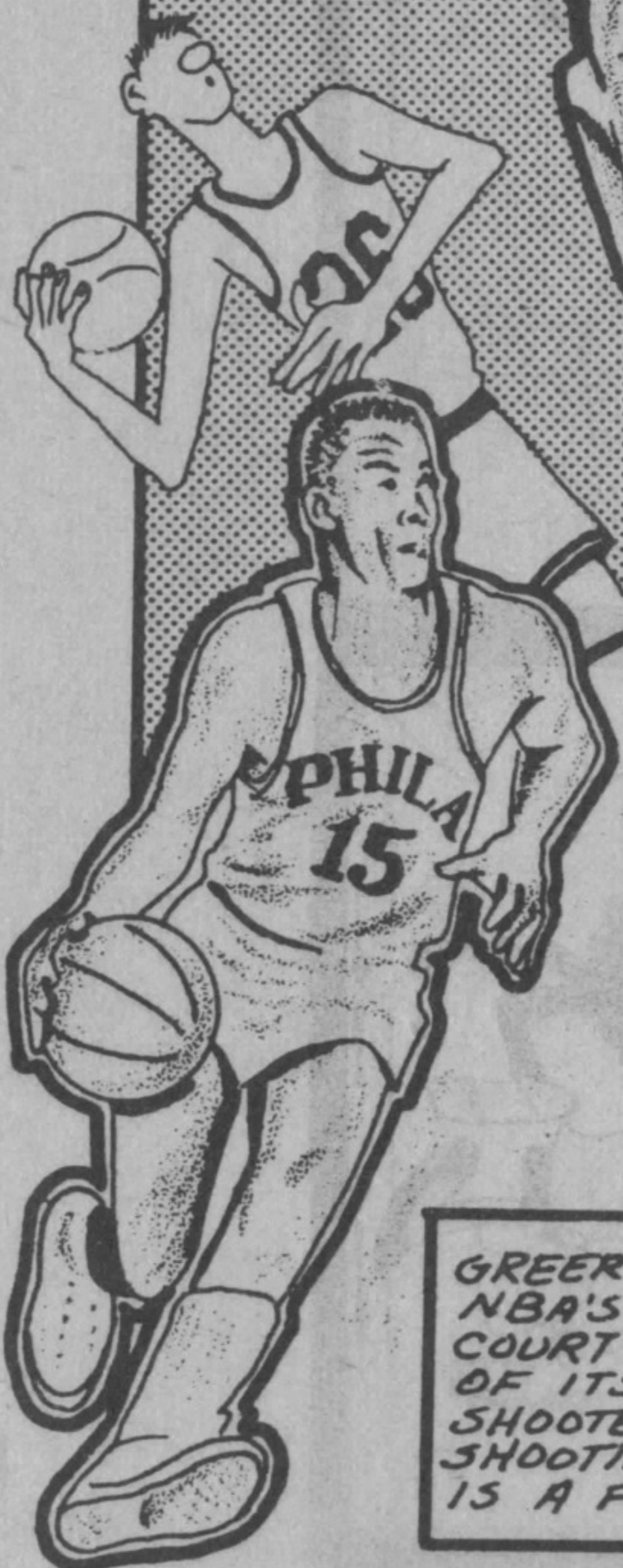

Keith Penner, Member of Parliament for Thunder Bay, has called upon the Federal Government to adopt recommendations which would allow for absentee voting during general elections. A 1968 commission suggested that if necessary, electors be permitted to vote at polling places other than the one at which they are registered or, if outside the province, to mail their ballot back to the place of registration. Both these methods are presently used with advantage in Australia.
