The children from the Junior grades of Holy Angel's School took an active part in Mission Week. Rev.

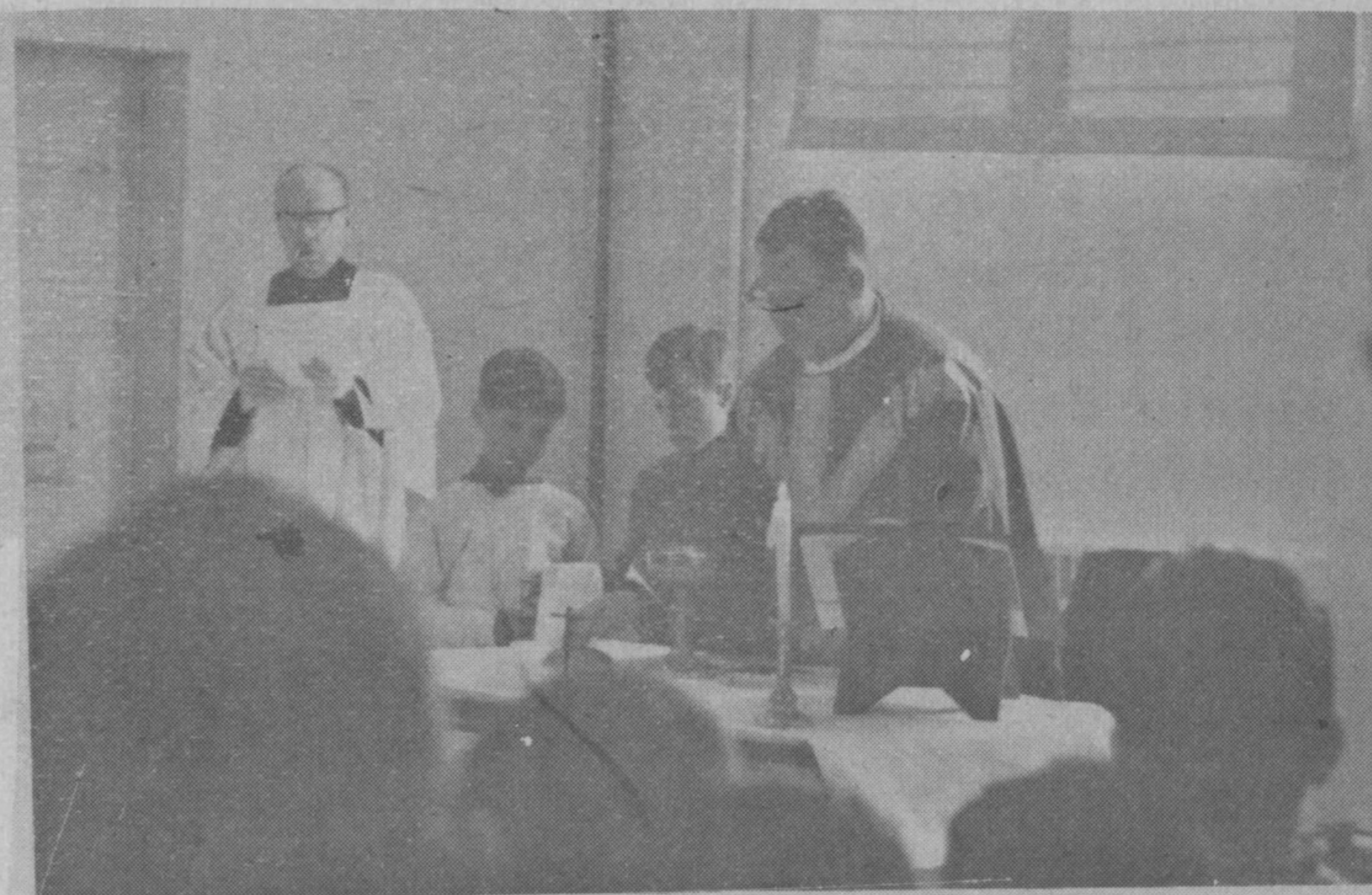
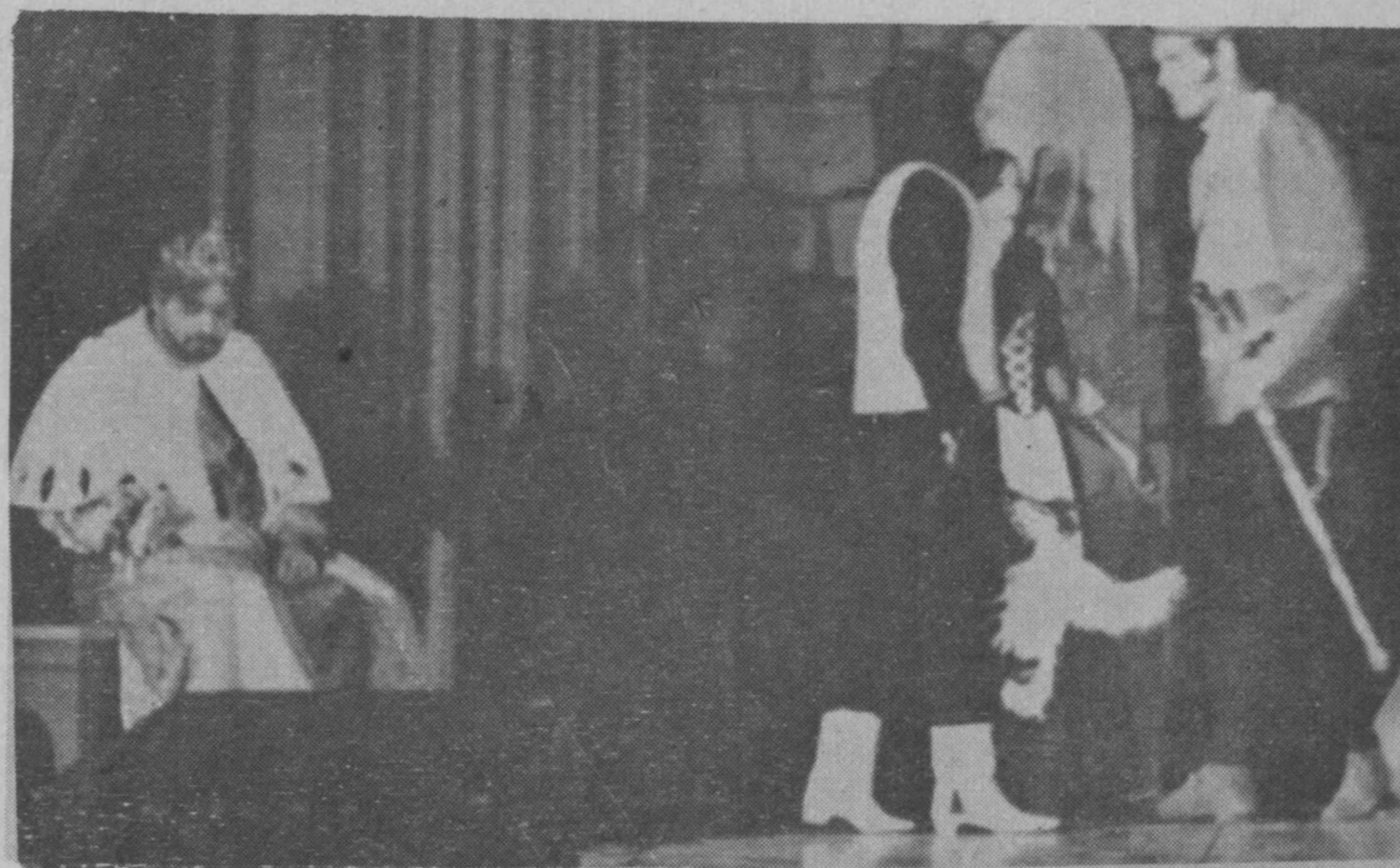
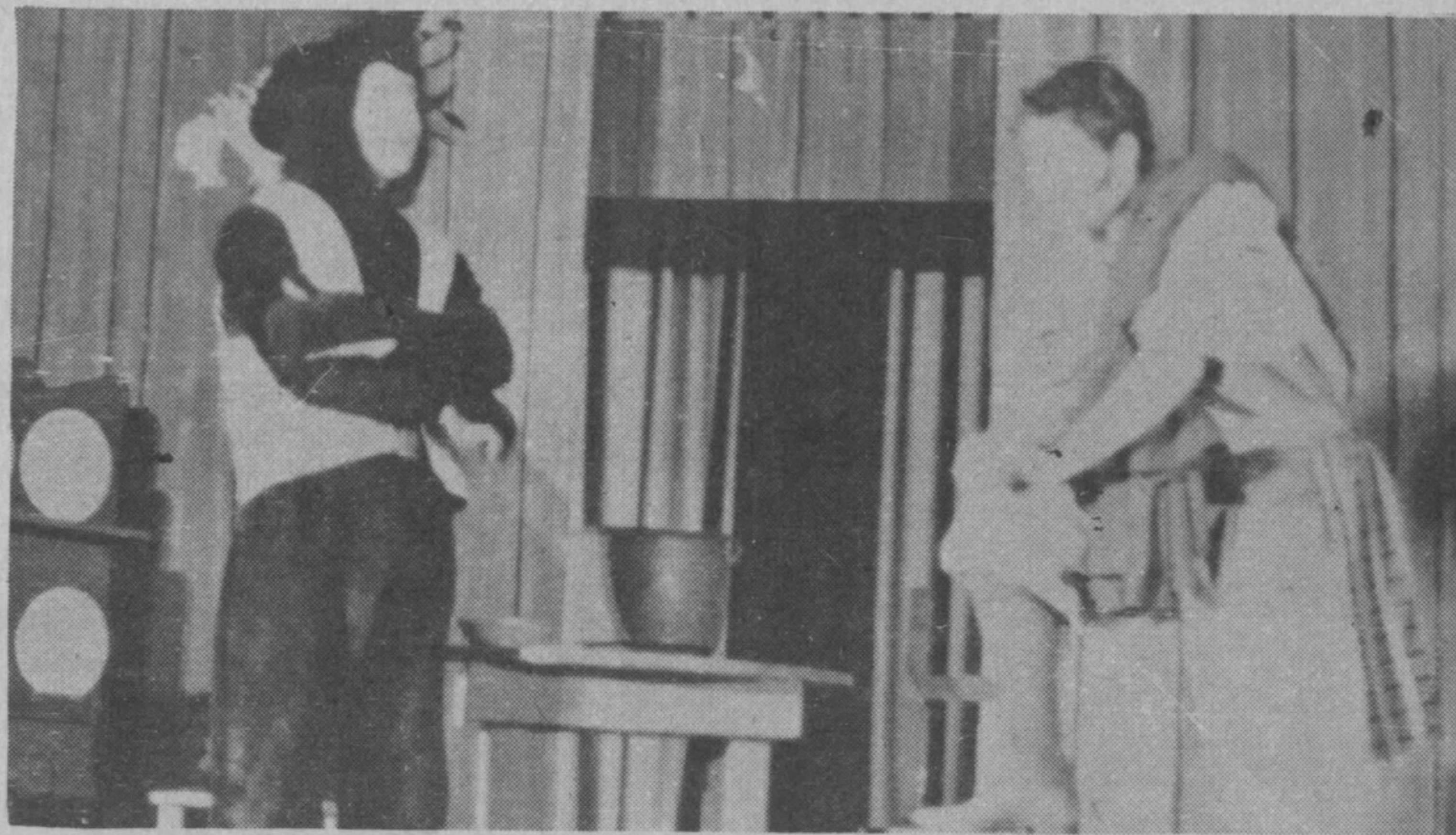
