## CP RAIL ANNOUNCES PASSENGER TRAIN SCHEDULES

Effective April 27 passenger trains will arrive in Terrace Bay as follows: Train No. 2 Eastbound 0107 EDT, Train No. 1 Westbound 1042 EDT.

Office hours are 0800 EDT to 1700 EDT. Monday through to Friday, closed on Saturday and Sunday. Waiting room remains open for passengers entraining and detraining. During closed hours at Terrace Bay, persons requiring to send telegrams, or make train reservations, please contact the CP Rail station at Schreiber.
