is a distinct pleasure to officially open this new provincial building which has been constructed by the Government of Ontario in order that we may improve the services of my department to the residents of and visitors to the North Shore area."

"This new building is, I trust, a fitting and welcome addition to you attractive community. It should be regarded by the residents of this and adjacent communities as an indication of the Ontario Government confidence in the development and growth of the North Shore area of Northwestern Ontario."

"We value the visits by tourists and endeavour to create a desire for their return and for their friends to visit us. We are in the midst of a park development programme in the area which is aimed at attracting more tourists."

"To ensure safe drinking water supplies and a high standard of sanitation in these parks, we have, in the past two years, installed three treated and pressurized water systems. Because of the trend to the use of camper trailers we have installed two sanitary dumping stations."

"A new gatehouse has been built at Rainbow Falls
Park and another is being built at Neys Park this
year. A comfort station with hot showers is being
built at Neys this year and electric outlets are being
installed in many of the trailer sites there."

"This rapid development of the camping facilities in our parks is to attract more tourists to the Superior North Shore. Our efforts, however, are not being restricted to campsite development but include nature trails and scenic location development and additional and improved brochures on the history, the flora and the fauna of the area."
