13-pounder Takes Top Prize at Terrace Bay's Annual Fish Derby



The first of several fish derbies to be held by north shore communities, the Terrace Bay third annual fish derby held on July 1st attracted over 200 fishermen from all parts of the district. Winner of the event was Ray Kenney of Terrace Bay and formerly of Rosspport who captured the first prize, a 16-foot boat, with a 13-pound 1½ ounce lake trout. Other prize-winning fish are shown
