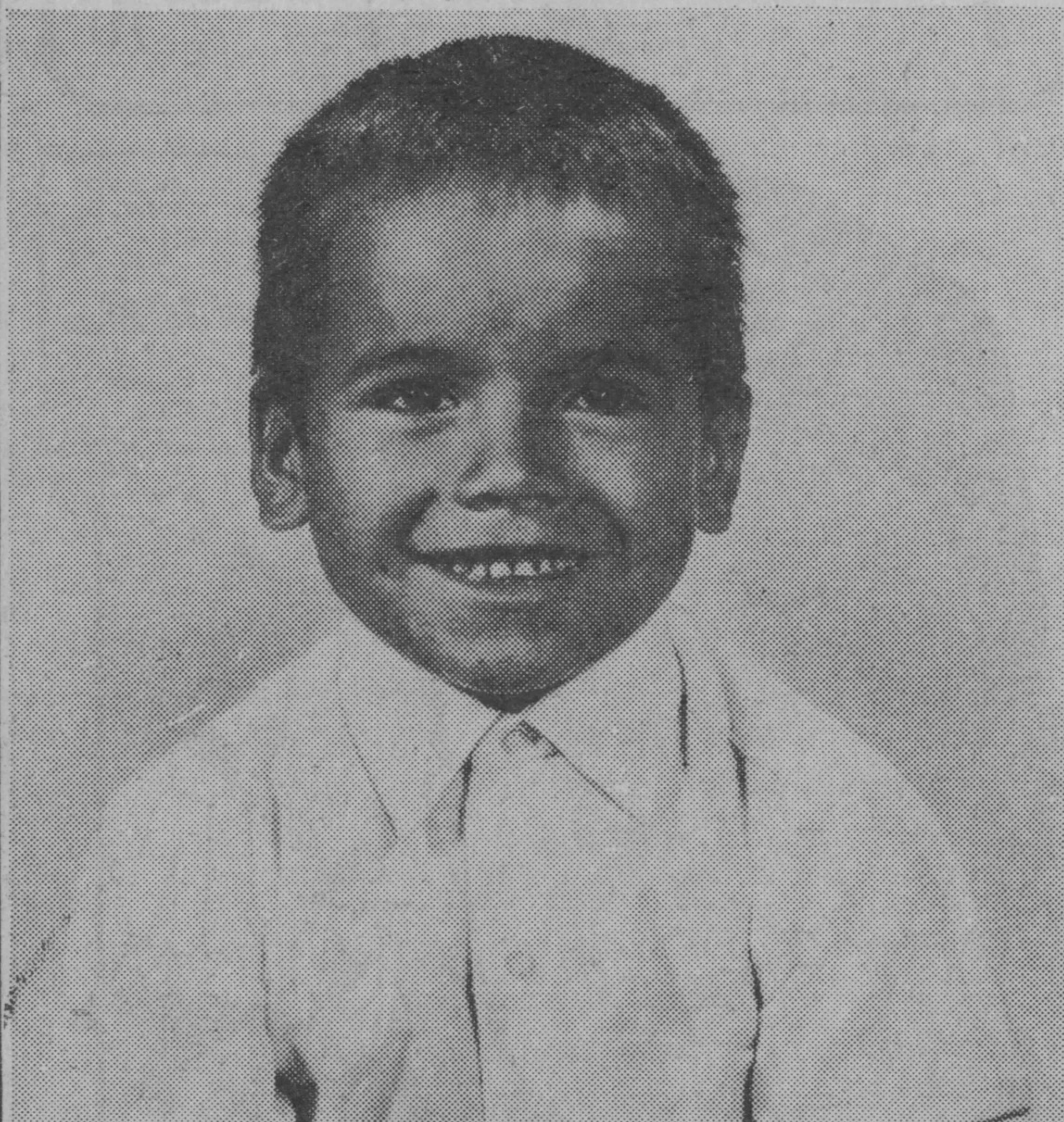


TODAY'S CHILD
