at a local service station. Council stated they will consider what steps may be taken to control this matter.

A letter was received from Pinewood Court requesting Terrace Bay's share of operating expenses.

An application was made by P. Fenlon, of the Gulf Station, for a Garage license, and this was approved.

A letter to Kimberly Clark requested an area be set aside on lot 120 for Municipal purposes, and if done, Council would relinquish their hold in Lot 11. Mr. Ferrier, Mill Manager, advised a reply would be forthcoming by August 15 approximately.

The Fire Department advised there had been no fires in July. The Building Inspector reported three garages were being built, 5300 permits being issued.

The Police Department reported the following - 31 warnings issued to motorists; motorcycles have been less active at night; 2 dogs were destroyed at owners request; and 9 bears had been shot, having had been seen in the townsite. One motorist was charged under the Criminal Code and 3 under the Liquor Control Act.

Accounts passed for payment were: - Township - \$219,306.24; Hydro - \$8,676.72; Library \$465.03; Recreation \$7,008.90.
