gramme, oral French, remedial teaching and music and art will be introduced in the elementary schools It was also decided that the annex to the Schreiber elementary school should be replaced by a modern addition to the school.

As evidence of the intentions of the Board, the Director was authorized to engage Mrs. L. Cormier to teach oral French in the Terrace Bay elementary school, and Mrs. M. Beacom to organize an opportunity class in the Manitouwadge elementary school,. The Board reaffirmed its intention to build three duplex dwellings as teacherages in Schreiber, and to procure further teacherages in Marathon.
