

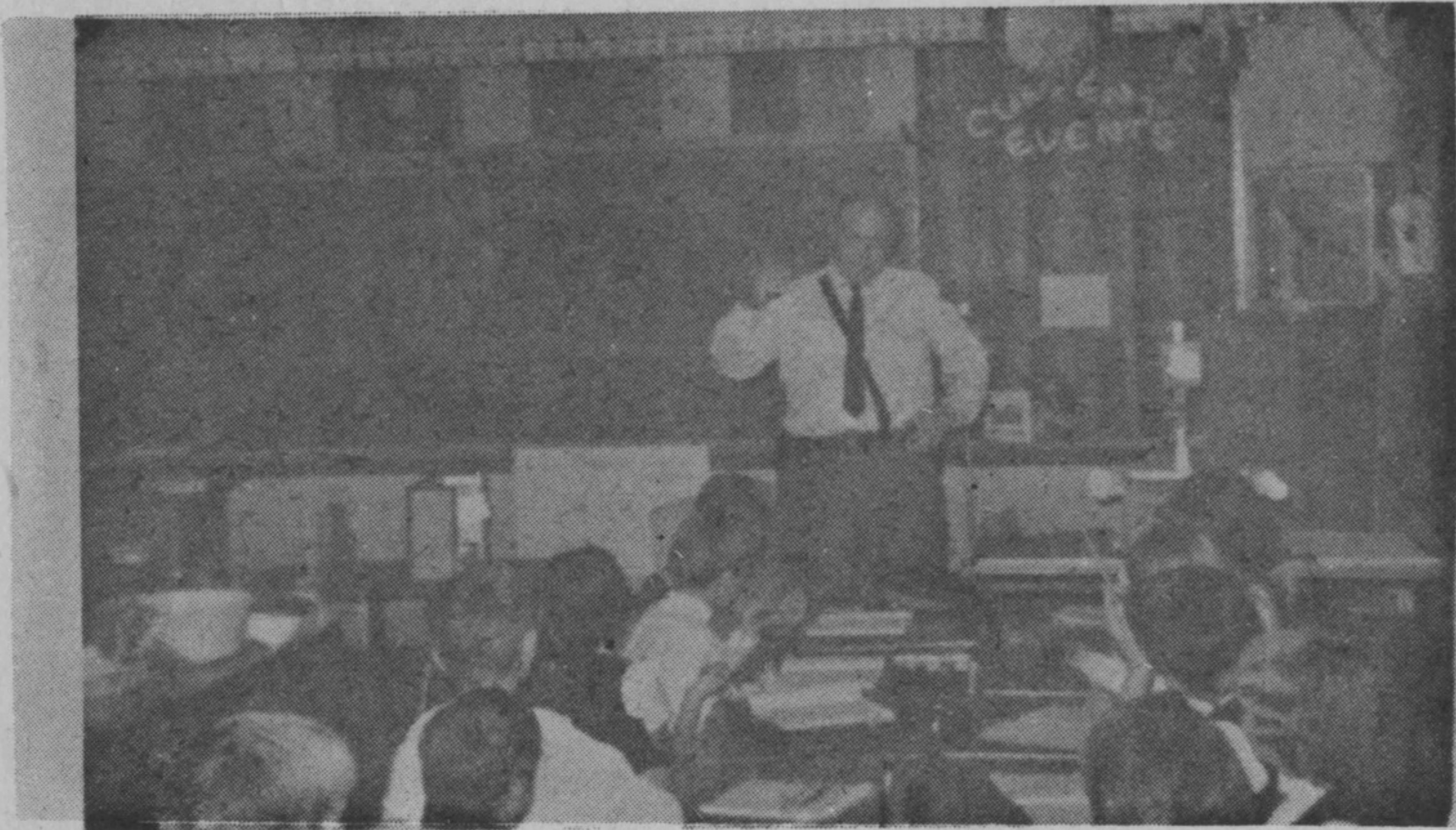


ACCIDENT PREVENTION
