

The 1969 series of bonds will become available on October 6th and will be sold at par until Nov. 14 The bonds will provide an average yield of 8 per cent if held to maturity in 9 years. The annual rate of interest is 7 per cent for the first year; 8 per. cent for the second and third years; and 8 1/4 per cent for each of the remaining six years.

Purchasers may also obtain twice their original investment if they refrain from cashing the bonds and the interest-bearing coupons until the maturity date in 1978.

During the 1968 campaign, more than 229,000 employees in plants and offices in Ontario purchased a record total of more than \$99 million worth of Canadian Savings Bonds.
