A plaque, bearing the Words "Lest We Forget", with the names of those of Branch 223 who have passed away, was presented to the President by Paul Coupal.

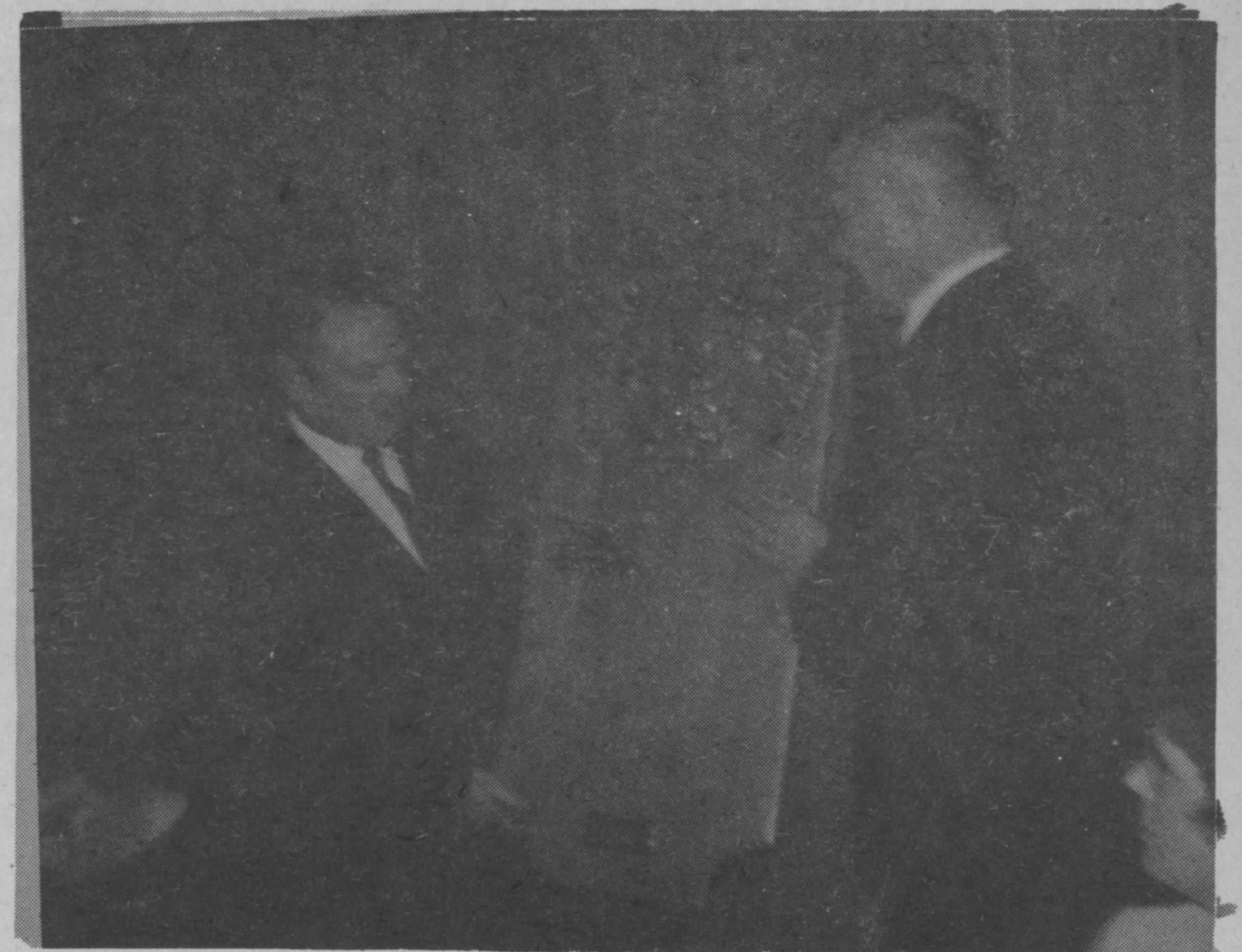
Mrs. Dorothy Ballentine, President of the Ladies Auxiliary to the Branch, presented a cheque to the
