ART CLUB PLANS NIGHT CLASSES

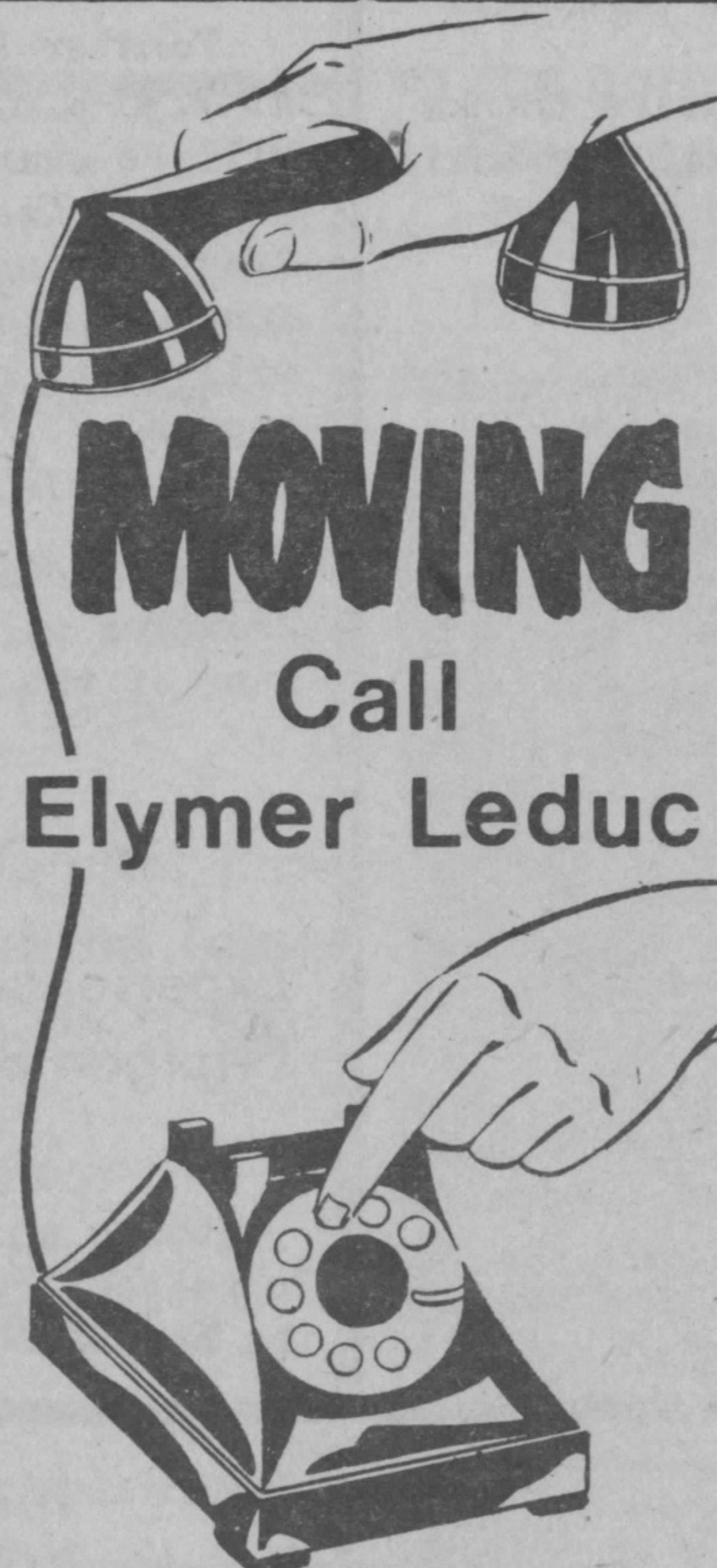
The November 6th meeting of the Art Club opened with minutes of the previous meeting read.
