They discussed proposed highways crossings and certain safety measures that would make it a better year for all those involved.

Entering into town business, it was announced that a new Recreation Director has been hired. He is Mr. G. Dupas who comes to us from Manitouwadge.

Correspondence included a letter sent to Mr. F. Anderson and Mr. Jack Brooks, of the Recreation Committee and the Library Board respectively, informing them of the social evening to be held on December 3rd, for the Library Board, members of the Recreation Committee and Town Council and their wives and husbands.

A committee of area residents in the Lakeview and Superior division requested permission to use the hydrant to flood a skating rink.

The District Assessors office notified Council of

a meeting to be held in the Lakehead discussing tax billing through data processing. Clerk Bill Hanley will attend.

Mr. Morpurgo, of Regional Planning office for the Department of Municipal Affairs stated he would be in Terrace Bay and would discuss any problems pertaining to zoning by-laws.

The Terrace Bay High School asked permission to sell chocolate bars in Town. Permission granted.

A letter was received from Levitt Safety Co. pertaining to freezing hydrants, this was directed to Fire Chief Vic Thorpe.

Pinewood Court requested donations toward the purchase of an organ. The letter was filed.

A copy from the Thunder Bay District Health Unit Medical Officer Report was received.
