Decorate the cover of a large plastic dish with colored shells. Fill the dish with cotton powder puffs - get a package of asorted colors.

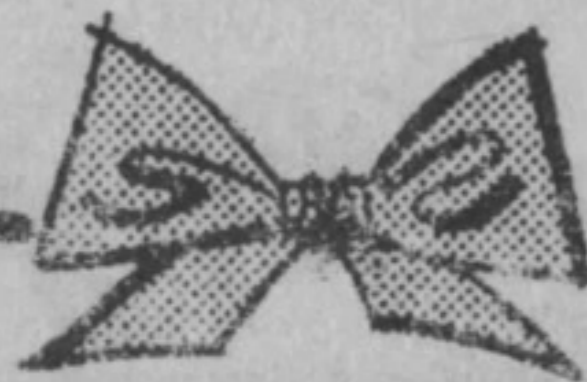
FOR YOUR TABLE
