PAPER NO. 2 - "SAFETY MEETING" - "Safety principles and their application to the man on the job," was the keynote of an address delivered by E.J. Brady in inaugurating the first of a series of safety lectures last Wednesday in the Recreation Hall.

Mr. Brady went into considerable detail on the cause and prevention of accidents and stressed the importance of receiving prompt medical attention in all cases of injury whether they appear trivial or not continued next column ....

"By taking unnecessary risks you are not playing fair to yourself or to your employer," he stated.

Added precautions should be exercised by every employee particularly at this time of the year when weather conditions present additional hazards."
