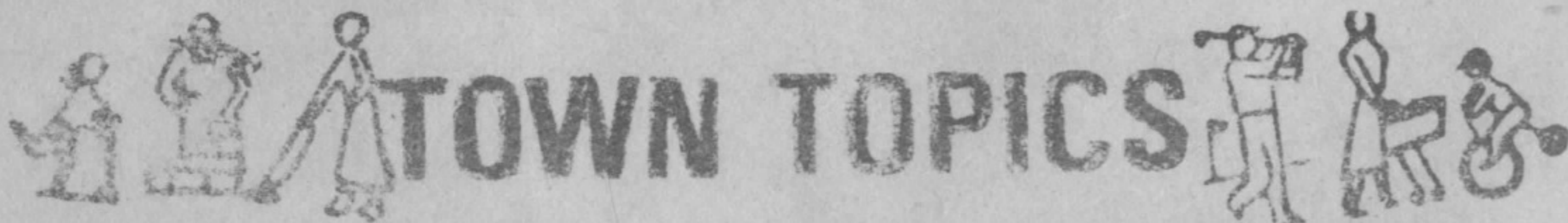

Several memberships on various Municipal associations were approved.

Application for electric data processing tax billing has been sent to the District Assessor's Data Centre, and it is expected the first of the new type bills will be in the mail by January 30th.

The Police Report was as follows: - one person charged under the Liquor Control Act and fined \$12.50; one person charged with impaired driving, fined \$200. and his license suspended for six months one person charged with assault, fined \$50. and costs, and paid for a new set of teeth; one case of quart of liquor stolen from private home and is still under investigation; there were three car accidents with two charges laid; three men found almost asphyxiated in private home, all taken to hospital, two in cruiser and one by ambulance; stone was thrown through a window in private home - under investigation; one case of a party having stolen a

car and almost \$500., a warrant has been issued, and a circular sent out to three provinces. During the Christmas season, the police were called to the Roxy Theatre, to eject teenagers who were being troublesome.

The Post Office lobby is being used as hangout for young people, and the Police Department recommend that it be locked after 8 o'clock at night.

One snowmobile machine hit a guywire on the highway, causing a power blackout for one hour. The case of stolen liquor taken from the Curling club lounge has been solved and the liquor replaced or paid for.

The Police Department also recommended that the doors to the Arena should be manned during hockey games.
