

2. It is proposed to raise the whole of the annual payments by an annual rate estimated at .71 mills over a term of twenty years.

The following is an example of the annual charge on an average dwelling property assessed at \$10,000.00:

<u>Assessment</u>	<u>Estimated Annual Mill Rate</u>	<u>Annual Payment</u>
\$10,000.00	.71	\$7.10

3. (a) Such sewer and water works rate is to be levied on Water Area No. 1 and Sewer Area No. 1, as enlarged, composed of:

- (i) All of registered plan M-121
- (ii) All of registered plan M-143
- (iii) All of registered plan M-226

(b) No exemptions will be granted.

4. Any ratepayer may, within twenty-one days after the first publication of this notice, send by prepaid post to the clerk of the Township of Terrace Bay, at the address given below, a notice in writing stating his objection to such approval or to the imposition of the special rate, or to the enlargement of the areas.

5. The Ontario Municipal Board may approve the said works, and the enlargement of the said areas, but before doing so it may appoint a time and place for a public hearing when any objections will be considered, but notice of such hearing will be given only to those persons who have given notice of objection as provided for above.

6. Copies of registered plans M-121, M-143 and M-226 may be inspected at the office of the said clerk during business hours.
