Sandra Ross was home for the holiday, from Confederation College, Thunder Bay, and John Ross from Cambrian College, Sault Ste. Marie.

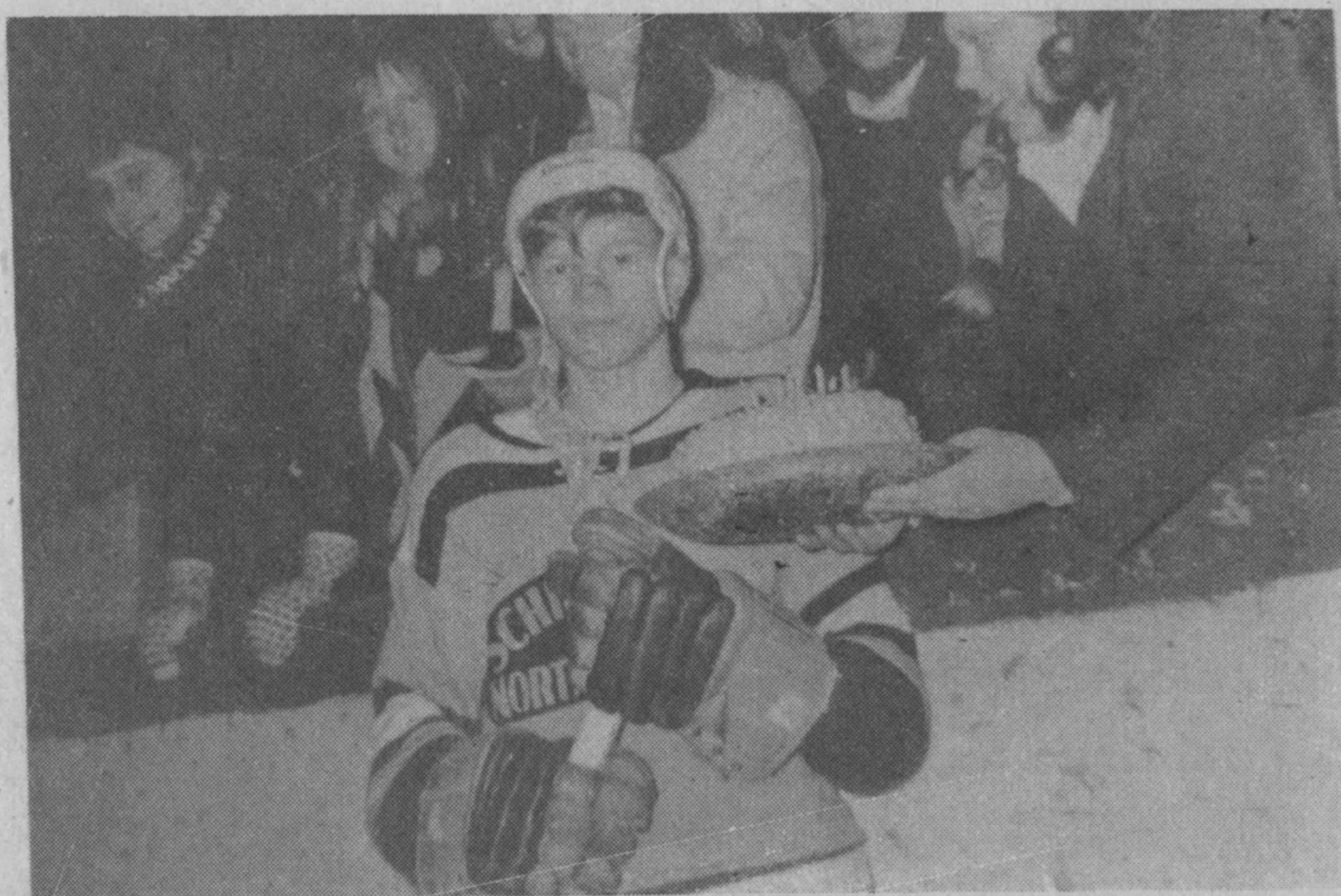
