RETAIL SALES TAX CHANGES

A recent bulletin from the Ontario Department of Revenue outlines recent changes in the Retail Sales Tax. The following changes should be noted: "Place of Amusement" - Act 1 (7a) - The paragraph has been expanded to include, in addition to those places already mentioned in it, a place where a public dance is held if liquor, beer or wine are served at the dance. This means a 10 percent tax must be collected on the price of admission to such dances, or otherwise in accordance with Act 2 (1c). "Production for own Use" - Act 1 (11) (g) - The definition of "sale" now includes the consumption of a taxable service by a vendor who produced the taxable service.
